AN ACT to amend the public health law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting the sale of liquid nico-tine to minors

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 1399-cc of the public health law, as amended by 2 chapter 131 of the laws of 2011, subdivisions 2, 3, 4 and 7 as amended 3 by chapter 448 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:

4 S 1399-cc. Sale of tobacco products, herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICO-5 TINE, shisha, rolling papers or smoking paraphernalia to minors prohib-6 ited. 1. As used in this section:

7 (a) "A device capable of deciphering any electronically readable 8 format" or "device" shall mean any commercial device or combination of 9 devices used at a point of sale or entry that is capable of reading the 10 information encoded on the bar code or magnetic strip of a driver's 11 license or non-driver identification card issued by the state commis-12 sioner of motor vehicles;

13 (b) "Card holder" means any person presenting a driver's license or 14 non-driver identification card to a licensee, or to the agent or employ-15 ee of such licensee under this chapter;

16 (c) "Smoking paraphernalia" means any pipe, water pipe, hookah, roll-17 ing papers, vaporizer or any other device, equipment or apparatus 18 designed for the inhalation of tobacco; [and]

(d) "Transaction scan" means the process involving an automated bar code reader by which a licensee, or agent or employee of a licensee under this chapter reviews a driver's license or non-driver identification card presented as a precondition for the purchase of a tobacco product or herbal cigarettes pursuant to subdivision three of this section; AND

25 (E) "LIQUID NICOTINE" OR "E-LIQUID" MEANS ANY LIQUID PRODUCT COMPOSED 26 EITHER IN WHOLE OR IN PART OF PURE NICOTINE AND PROPYLENE GLYCOL AND 27 MANUFACTURED FOR USE WITH ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES OR OTHER SMOKING

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1 PARAPHERNALIA THAT MAY BE FLAVORED AND MAY HAVE ADDED COLORINGS OR CHEM-2 ICALS.

3 2. Any person operating a place of business wherein tobacco products, 4 herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICOTINE, shisha or electronic cigarettes, are 5 sold or offered for sale is prohibited from selling such products, 6 herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICOTINE, shisha, electronic cigarettes or 7 smoking paraphernalia to individuals under eighteen years of aqe, and 8 shall post in a conspicuous place a sign upon which there shall be imprinted the following statement, "SALE OF CIGARETTES, CIGARS, CHEWING 9 10 TOBACCO, POWDERED TOBACCO, SHISHA OR OTHER TOBACCO PRODUCTS, HERBAL 11 CIGARETTES, LIQUID NICOTINE, ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES, ROLLING PAPERS OR 12 SMOKING PARAPHERNALIA, TO PERSONS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE IS PROHIB-13 ITED BY LAW." Such sign shall be printed on a white card in red letters 14 at least one-half inch in height.

15 3. Sale of tobacco products, herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICOTINE, shisha or electronic cigarettes in such places, other than by a vending 16 machine, shall be made only to an individual who demonstrates, 17 through a valid driver's license or non-driver's identification card issued 18 (a) 19 by the commissioner of motor vehicles, the federal government, any United States territory, commonwealth or possession, the District of 20 21 Columbia, a state government within the United States or a provincial 22 government of the dominion of Canada, or (b) a valid passport issued by the United States government or any other country, or (c) an identifica-23 24 tion card issued by the armed forces of the United States, indicating 25 the individual is at least eighteen years of age. Such identificathat 26 tion need not be required of any individual who reasonably appears to be 27 at least twenty-five years of age, provided, however, that such appear-28 shall not constitute a defense in any proceeding alleging the sale ance 29 of a tobacco product, herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICOTINE, shisha or electronic cigarettes to an individual under eighteen years of age. 30

4. (a) Any person operating a place of business wherein tobacco products, herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICOTINE, shisha or electronic cigarettes are sold or offered for sale may perform a transaction scan as a precondition for such purchases.

(b) In any instance where the information deciphered by the transaction scan fails to match the information printed on the driver's license or non-driver identification card, or if the transaction scan indicates that the information is false or fraudulent, the attempted transaction shall be denied.

40 In any proceeding pursuant to section thirteen hundred ninety-(C) nine-ee of this article, it shall be an affirmative defense that such 41 person had produced a driver's license or non-driver identification card 42 43 apparently issued by a governmental entity, successfully completed that 44 transaction scan, and that the tobacco product [or], herbal cigarettes LIQUID NICOTINE had been sold, delivered or given to such person in 45 OR reasonable reliance upon such identification and transaction scan. 46 In 47 evaluating the applicability of such affirmative defense the commission-48 er shall take into consideration any written policy adopted and imple-49 mented by the seller to effectuate the provisions of this chapter. Use 50 a transaction scan shall not excuse any person operating a place of of 51 business wherein tobacco products, herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICOTINE, shisha or electronic cigarettes are sold, or the agent or employee of 52 such person, from the exercise of reasonable diligence otherwise 53 54 required by this chapter. Notwithstanding the above provisions, any such 55 affirmative defense shall not be applicable in any civil or criminal proceeding, or in any other forum. 56

5. A licensee or agent or employee of such licensee shall only use a 1 2 device capable of deciphering any electronically readable format, and 3 shall only use the information recorded and maintained through the use 4 of such devices, for the purposes contained in subdivision four of this 5 section. No licensee or agent or employee of a licensee shall resell or 6 disseminate the information recorded during such a scan to any third 7 person. Such prohibited resale or dissemination includes but is not limited to any advertising, marketing or promotional activities. Notwithstanding the restrictions imposed by this subdivision, such 8 9 10 records may be released pursuant to a court ordered subpoena or pursuant to any other statute that specifically authorizes the release of 11 such information. Each violation of this subdivision shall be punishable by a 12 civil penalty of not more than one thousand dollars. 13

14 6. A licensee or agent or employee of such a licensee may electron-15 ically or mechanically record and maintain only the information from a transaction scan necessary to effectuate this section. Such information 16 17 shall be limited to the following: (a) name, (b) date of birth, (C) driver's license or non-driver identification number, and (d) expiration 18 19 date. The commissioner and state commissioner of motor vehicles shall 20 jointly promulgate any regulations necessary to govern the recording and 21 maintenance of these records by a licensee under this chapter. The 22 commissioner and the state liquor authority shall jointly promulgate any 23 regulation necessary to ensure quality control in the use of the transaction scan devices under this chapter and article five of the alcoholic 24 25 beverage control law.

7. No person operating a place of business wherein tobacco products, 26 herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICOTINE, shisha or electronic cigarettes are 27 28 sold or offered for sale shall sell, permit to be sold, offer for sale 29 or display for sale any tobacco product, herbal cigarettes, LIQUID NICO-TINE, shisha or electronic cigarettes in any manner, unless such 30 products and cigarettes are stored for sale (a) behind a counter in an 31 32 area accessible only to the personnel of such business, or (b) in a 33 locked container; provided, however, such restriction shall not apply to 34 tobacco businesses, as defined in subdivision eight of section thirteen 35 hundred ninety-nine-aa of this article, and to places to which admission is restricted to persons eighteen years of age or older. 36

37 S 2. Section 17-706 of the administrative code of the city of New 38 York, as amended by local law number 94 of the city of New York for the 39 year 2013, is amended to read as follows:

40 S 17-706 Sale of cigarettes, tobacco products, LIQUID NICOTINE, or 41 electronic cigarettes to minors and young adults prohibited.

a. Any person operating a place of business wherein cigarettes, tobac-42 43 co products, LIQUID NICOTINE, or electronic cigarettes are sold or 44 offered for sale is prohibited from selling such cigarettes, tobacco 45 products, LIQUID NICOTINE, or electronic cigarettes to individuals under twenty-one years of age. Sale of cigarettes, tobacco products, LIQUID 46 47 or electronic cigarettes in such places shall be made only to NICOTINE, 48 an individual who demonstrates, through a driver's license or other 49 photographic identification card issued by a government entity or educa-50 tional institution, that the individual is at least twenty-one years of 51 age. Such identification need not be required of any individual who reasonably appears to be at least thirty years of age, provided, howev-52 er, that such appearance shall not constitute a defense in any proceed-53 54 ing alleging the sale of cigarettes, tobacco products, LIQUID NICOTINE 55 or electronic cigarettes to an individual under twenty-one years of age.

b. Any person operating a place of business wherein non-tobacco 1 shisha, pipes, or rolling papers are sold or offered for sale is prohib-2 3 ited from selling such non-tobacco shisha, pipes, or rolling papers to 4 individuals under eighteen years of age. Sale of non-tobacco shisha, pipes, or rolling papers in such places shall be made only to an indi-5 6 vidual who demonstrates, through a driver's license or other photograph-7 ic identification card issued by a government entity or educational institution, that the individual is at least eighteen years of age. Such 8 identification need not be required of any individual who reasonably 9 10 appears to be at least twenty-five years of age, provided, however, that such appearance shall not constitute a defense in any proceeding alleg-11 12 ing the sale of non-tobacco shisha, pipes, or rolling papers to an indi-13 vidual under eighteen years of age.

c. Any person operating a place of business wherein cigarettes, tobacproducts, LIQUID NICOTINE, electronic cigarettes, herbal cigarettes, non-tobacco shisha, pipes, or rolling papers are sold or offered for sale shall post in a conspicuous place a sign, in accordance with the rules of the department, advising persons about the minimum age requirements for the purchase of such items.

S 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that if local law number 94 of the city of New York for the year 2013 shall not have taken effect on or before such date then section two of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as local law number 94 of the city of New York for the year 2013, takes effect.
