AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to providing notice to applicants of potential liability for public assistance benefits

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The social services law is amended by adding a new section 2 110-b to read as follows:

110-B. RECOVERY FROM A PERSON DISCOVERED TO HAVE PROPERTY; NOTICE AND INFORMED CONSENT. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LAW, RULE OR REGULATION TO 5 THE CONTRARY, AN APPLICANT FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE SHALL FULLY INFORMED, ORALLY AND IN WRITING, THAT HE OR SHE MAY BE LIABLE REIM-BURSE THE STATE FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFITS RECEIVED, AS PROVIDED FOR 8 TITLE. SUCH APPLICANT SHALL SIGN AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM, THIS 9 PROVIDED BY THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE, 10 FROM OTHER APPLICATION-RELATED FORMS, AND THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL KEEP SUCH ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM IN SUCH APPLICANT'S FILE; PROVIDED, HOWEV-11 ER, THAT PRODUCTION OF SUCH FORM SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED FOR THE RECOVERY 12 13 PUBLIC WELFARE BENEFITS. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEEMED TO

14 PREVENT THE LOCAL SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT FROM MAINTAINING ITS RECORDS

15 ELECTRONICALLY.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect on June 30, 2015.
