AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to meetings of the board of regents

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 204 of the education law is amended to read as  
2 follows:  
3     S 204. Meetings and absences. The regents may provide for regular  
4 meetings, and the chancellor, or the commissioner of education, or any  
5 five regents, may at any time call a special meeting of the board of  
6 regents and fix the time and place therefor; and at least ten days'  
7 notice of every meeting shall be mailed to the usual address of each  
8 regent. If any regent shall fail to attend three consecutive meetings,  
9 without excuse accepted as satisfactory by the regents, he may be deemed  
10 to have resigned and the regents shall then report the vacancy to the  
11 legislature, which shall fill it. THE REGENTS SHALL HOLD AT LEAST ONE  
12 MEETING IN EACH CALENDAR YEAR IN EACH JUDICIAL DISTRICT OUTSIDE OF NEW  
13 YORK CITY AND AT LEAST ONE MEETING IN EACH CALENDAR YEAR IN NEW YORK  
14 CITY.  
15     S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding  
16 the date on which it shall have become a law. Effective immediately,  
17 the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary  
18 for the implementation of this act on its effective date is authorized  
19 to be made on or before such date.
