AN ACT to amend the state law, in relation to cessation of jurisdiction of a parcel of land comprising part of the West Point Military Reservation

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The state law is amended by adding a new section 52-c to 2 read as follows:

- S 52-C. GOVERNOR MAY EXECUTE DEED OR RELEASE WITH SUNDRY RESERVATIONS; STONY LONESOME AND RANGE AREAS, WEST POINT MILITARY RESERVATION. 1. 5 NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION FIFTY-SEVEN OF THIS ARTICLE, THE GOVERNOR IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO CEDE TO THE UNITED STATES FULL CONCURRENT JURISDIC-TION OVER THE TRACTS OF LAND COMPRISING THE STONY LONESOME 8 AREAS OUTSIDE THE STONY LONESOME AND THAYER GATES, UNITED STATES MILI-9 TARY ACADEMY, WEST POINT MILITARY RESERVATION, EXCLUDING U.S. 10 AND STATE ROUTES 218 AND 293, ACQUIRED BY THE UNITED STATES FOR MILITARY PURPOSES UPON CONDITIONS THAT THE JURISDICTION SO CEDED SHOULD NOT 11 PREVENT THE EXECUTION ON SUCH TRACTS OF ANY PROCESS, CIVIL OR CRIMINAL, 12 13 ISSUED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THIS STATE, NOR PREVENT FROM OPERATING WITHIN THE BOUNDS OF SUCH TRACTS ANY OF THE LAWS OR REGULATIONS 14 STATE, NOT INCOMPATIBLE WITH THE FREE USE AND ENJOYMENT OF THE PREMISES 15 BY THE UNITED STATES OR THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH SUCH CESSION IS MADE, NOR 16 PREVENT FROM OPERATING WITHIN THE SAME TRACTS OR PARCELS OF 17 LAND 18 LAWS OR ORDINANCES OF THE COUNTY OF ORANGE, TOWN OF HIGHLANDS, OR THE 19 VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND FALLS, NOT INCOMPATIBLE WITH THE FREE USE AND ENJOY-20 MENT OF THE PREMISES BY THE UNITED STATES OR THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH SUCH 21 CESSION IS MADE; AND THAT THE UNITED STATES SHALL RETAIN SUCH JURISDIC-22 SO LONG ONLY AS SUCH TRACTS OR PARCELS OF LAND SHALL BE USED FOR TION 23 MILITARY PURPOSES.
- 24 2. SECTIONS FIFTY-TWO, FIFTY-THREE, FIFTY-FIVE AND FIFTY-SIX OF THIS 25 ARTICLE SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 26 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
