AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the replacement of lighting ballasts and lighting fixtures in buildings constructed between 1950 and 1978 that are used as schools and requiring the promulgation of regulations by the state department of education

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subchapter 7 of chapter 1 of title 27 of the administrative 2 code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new article 23 to 3 read as follows:

ARTICLE 23

SCHOOL BUILDINGS CONSTRUCTED BETWEEN 1950 AND 1978

6 SECTION 27-521.20 LIGHTING BALLASTS AND LIGHTING FIXTURES IN SCHOOL 7 BUILDINGS.

27-521.25 FINANCING AND REMEDIATION.

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9 27-521.20 LIGHTING BALLASTS AND LIGHTING FIXTURES IN SCHOOL BUILD-S 10 INGS. (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPLACE ALL LIGHTING BALLASTS AND LIGHT-FIXTURES IN ANY BUILDING CONSTRUCTED OR SUBSTANTIALLY RENOVATED 11 ING 12 BETWEEN THE YEARS NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY AND NINETEEN HUNDRED 13 SEVENTY-EIGHT THAT IS CURRENTLY USED AS A SCHOOL.

14 (B) FOLLOWING THE REPLACEMENT OF ANY LIGHTING BALLASTS OR LIGHTING 15 FIXTURES PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION (A) OF THIS SECTION, EACH SITE SHALL BE

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TESTED FOR THE PRESENCE OF POLYCHLORINATED BIPHENYLS. RESULTS SHALL BE 1 2 POSTED ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE WITHIN FOUR DAYS OF RECEIVING TEST 3 RESULTS.

4 (C) SCHOOL BUILDINGS SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM SUBDIVISION (A) OF THIS 5 SECTION IF THE LIGHTING BALLASTS AND LIGHTING FIXTURES HAVE BEEN 6 REPLACED USING MATERIALS NOT CONTAINING POLYCHLORINATED BIPHENYLS. 7

(D) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:

(1) "DEPARTMENT" SHALL MEAN THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

9 (2) "SCHOOL" SHALL MEAN EACH SCHOOL WITHIN THE NEW YORK CITY PUBLIC 10 SCHOOL SYSTEM THAT PROVIDES EDUCATIONAL INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS AT OR BELOW THE TWELFTH GRADE LEVEL. 11

S 27-521.25 FINANCING AND REMEDIATION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COORDINATE 12 FINANCING AND REMEDIATION IN CONSULTATION WITH RELEVANT STATE AGENCIES 13 14 AND THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND SHALL BE 15 REQUIRED TO SEARCH FOR FEDERAL AND STATE FINANCING TO ACCOMPLISH SUCH 16 PURPOSE.

17 S 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state education department shall implement and enforce rules or regulations 18 19 necessary to effectuate the provisions of this act. The state education department shall establish deadlines to ensure expedited remediation and 20 21 testing of lighting ballasts and lighting fixtures in school buildings 22 constructed between 1950 and 1978 and shall require that fifty percent all replacement work shall be completed within one year and the 23 of 24 completion of all replacement work within two years from the effective 25 date of this act.

26 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided however that section one of this act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth 27 28 day after it shall have become a law.
