AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to equipping vehicles with radio devices

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 397 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by 2 chapter 843 of the laws of 1980, is amended to read as follows:

3 S 397. Equipping motor vehicles with radio receiving sets capable receiving signals on the frequencies allocated for police use. person, not a police officer or peace officer, acting pursuant 5 special duties, who equips a motor vehicle with a radio receiving set 7 capable of receiving signals on the frequencies allocated for police use or knowingly uses a motor vehicle so equipped or who in any way knowing-8 9 ly interferes with the transmission of radio messages by the police 10 without having first secured a permit so to do from the person authorized to issue such a permit by the local governing body or board of the 11 city, town or village in which such person resides, or where such person 12 13 resides outside of a city or village in a county having a county police department by the board of supervisors of such county, is guilty of a 14 15 misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars, or imprisonment not exceeding six months, or both. Nothing in this section 16 17 contained shall be construed to apply to any person who holds a valid 18 amateur radio operator's license issued by the federal communications commission and who operates a duly licensed portable mobile transmitter 19 20 in connection therewith a receiver or receiving set on frequencies 21 exclusively allocated by the federal communications commission 22 licensed radio amateurs, OR PROHIBIT ANY AUTHORIZED PERSON EMPLOYED BY THE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES FROM EQUIPPING 23 24 WITH AN AUTHORIZED, STATE-ISSUED AFFIXED, MOBILE OR PORTABLE RADIO APPARATUS CAPABLE OF TRANSMITTING OR RECEIVING 25 SIGNALS 26 ALLOCATED FOR POLICE OR USING A FREOUENCIES USE MOTOR VEHICLE SO 27 EOUIPPED.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
