Introduced by COMMITTEE ON RULES -- (at request of M. of A. Gottfried) -- read once and referred to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the palliative care education and training council; and to direct such council to examine and make recommendations relating to such training and education in nursing and social work schools

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 6 of section 2807-n of the public health law, as added by section 63-f of part C of chapter 58 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:

- (a) The New York state palliative care education and training council 5 established in the department as an expert panel in palliative medicine, education and training. Its members shall be appointed by the 7 commissioner. The commissioner shall seek recommendations for appoint-8 ments to such council from New York state-based health care profes-9 sional, consumer, medical institutional and medical educational leaders. the council shall include: nine representatives of medical 10 Members of schools and hospital organizations; two representatives of medical acad-11 12 emies; two patient advocates; individual representatives of an organiza-13 tion broadly representative of physicians, internal medicine, family 14 physicians, nursing, SOCIAL WORK, hospice, HOME CARE, neurology, psychi-15 atry, pediatrics, obstetrics-gynecology, surgery, and the hospital philanthropic community; and the executive director or a member of the 16 17 governor's taskforce on life and the law and of the New York state council on graduate medical education. Members shall have expertise in 18 19 palliative care or pain management. Members shall serve a term of three 20 years with renewable terms. Members shall receive no compensation for their services, but shall be allowed actual and necessary expenses in 21 the performance of their duties. 22
- 23 S 2. The palliative care education and training council established 24 pursuant to paragraph (a) of subdivision 6 of section 2807-n of the 25 public health law shall examine and make recommendations to the commis-26 sioners of health and education, the chancellor of the state university

of New York, and the chairs of the senate and assembly committees on health, education and higher education with regard to the need, approaches and resources to provide for palliative care education and training in state certified schools of nursing and social work, as well as in practice settings at the health care provider facility or agency level. In conducting the examination and making the recommendations, the council shall also solicit and consider the input of representatives of such schools of nursing and social work.

S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
