- AN ACT to amend the parks, recreation and historic preservation law, in relation to free passes for senior citizens

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of section 13.19 of the parks, recre-2 ation and historic preservation law is designated subdivision 1 and a 3 new subdivision 2 is added to read as follows:

2. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM WHEREBY SENIOR CITIZENS, 4 5 UPON PROOF OF AGE SIXTY-TWO OR OLDER, SHALL BE ISSUED ANNUAL PASSES AT 6 NO COST FOR DAILY PARKING, INCLUDING WEEKENDS, AT STATE PARK FACILITIES. S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 7 it shall have become a law, provided however that, effective immediate-8 the commissioner of parks, recreation and historic preservation 9 ly, 10 shall be authorized and directed to add, amend and/or repeal any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective 11 12 date.
