AN ACT to amend the tax law and the state finance law, in relation to providing a tax check-off box on personal income tax return forms for gifts to the school-based health centers fund

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 630-d to 2 read as follows:
  - 630-D. GIFT FOR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS. EFFECTIVE FOR ANY TAX YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOURTEEN, ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY ELECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO INDIVIDUAL ΙN THE SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS FUND. SUCH CONTRIBUTION SHALL WHOLE DOLLAR AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE TAX OWED BY
- 7 WHOLE DOLLAR AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE TAX OWED BY 8 SUCH INDIVIDUAL. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE SPACE ON THE PERSONAL 9 INCOME TAX RETURN TO ENABLE A TAXPAYER TO MAKE SUCH CONTRIBUTION. THE
- 10 COMMISSIONER SHALL ALSO ENSURE THAT A DESCRIPTION OF A SCHOOL-BASED
- 11 HEALTH CENTER IS INCLUDED WITHIN THE TAX FORM PREPARATION INSTRUCTION
- 12 BOOKLET. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW ALL REVENUES 13 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE SCHOOL-BASED
- 13 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE SCHOOL-BASEI 14 HEALTH CENTERS FUND AND USED ONLY FOR THOSE PURPOSES ENUMERATED IN
- 15 SECTION EIGHTY-ONE OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW.

16 S 2. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section 81 to 17 read as follows:

S 81. SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS FUND. 1. THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED IN THE JOINT CUSTODY OF THE COMPTROLLER AND THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH, A SPECIAL FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE "SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS FUND".

- 4 2. SUCH FUND SHALL CONSIST OF ALL REVENUES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE 5 PROVISIONS OF SECTION SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-D OF THE TAX LAW, AND ALL OTHER 6 MONEYS APPROPRIATED, CREDITED, OR TRANSFERRED THERETO FROM ANY OTHER 7 FUND OR SOURCE PURSUANT TO LAW. NOTHING CONTAINED HEREIN SHALL PREVENT 8 THE STATE FROM RECEIVING GRANTS, GIFTS OR BEQUESTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF 9 THE FUND AS DEFINED IN THIS SECTION AND DEPOSITING THEM INTO THE FUND 10 ACCORDING TO LAW.
- 11 3. MONIES OF THE FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED TO FUND EXPANSION OF MEDICAL 12 SERVICES AT EXISTING SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS OR TO ESTABLISH NEW 13 SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS.
- 4. MONIES SHALL BE PAYABLE FROM THE FUND ON THE AUDIT AND WARRANT OF THE COMPTROLLER ON VOUCHERS APPROVED AND CERTIFIED BY THE COMMISSIONER 16 OF HEALTH.
- 5. AMOUNTS EXPENDED FOR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE AMOUNT THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BE APPROPRIATED FOR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS UNDER ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW.
- 20 6. SERVICES PERFORMED BY SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS AVAILABLE FOR 21 MONEYS FROM THIS FUND SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO:
  - A. COMPREHENSIVE PHYSICAL HEALTH AND MENTAL HEALTH ASSESSMENTS;
  - B. DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF ACUTE ILLNESSES;
- 24 C. VISION, HEARING, DENTAL, NUTRITIONAL, AND TUBERCULOSIS SCREENINGS;
  - D. ROUTINE MANAGEMENT OF CHRONIC DISEASES;
- 26 E. HEALTH EDUCATION;
- 27 F. MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING AND REFERRALS;
- 28 G. IMMUNIZATIONS;
- 29 H. WORKING PAPERS AND SPORTS PHYSICALS; AND
- 30 I. POPULATION-BASED PRIMARY PREVENTION.
- 31 SERVICES SHALL BE PROVIDED ON-SITE BY A MULTI-DISCIPLINARY TEAM
- 32 CONSISTING OF A MID-LEVEL PRACTITIONER, A MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR, AND A
- 33 MEDICAL ASSISTANT IN CONSULTATION WITH A PHYSICIAN. THE CENTERS SHALL
- 34 ALSO PROVIDE ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE TWENTY-FOUR HOURS PER DAY, SEVEN DAYS
- 35 PER WEEK
