AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to an assault of emergency department personnel while such employee is performing an assigned duty in, or directly related to such hospital emergency department

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as
2 amended by chapter 259 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 3. With intent to prevent a peace officer, a police officer, prosecu-
5 tor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal
6 procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation
7 enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, a firefighter,
8 including a firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical tech-
9 nician administering first aid in the course of performance of duty as
10 such firefighter, an emergency medical service paramedic or emergency
11 medical service technician, or medical or related personnel in a hospi-
12 tal emergency department PERFORMING ANY PROFESSIONAL-RELATED DUTIES, a
13 city marshal, a traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement
14 agent, from performing a lawful duty, by means including releasing or
15 failing to control an animal under circumstances evincing the actor's
16 intent that the animal obstruct the lawful activity of such peace offi-
17 cer, police officer, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of
18 section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed
19 practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation
20 worker, firefighter, paramedic, technician, city marshal, traffic

14 employed by any transit agency, authority or company, public or private,
15 whose operation is authorized by New York state or any of its political
16 subdivisions, a city marshal, a traffic enforcement officer, traffic
17 enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of
18 section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, sanitation enforcement
19 agent, New York city sanitation worker, registered nurse or licensed
20 practical nurse, TECHNICIAN OR MEDICAL OR RELATED PERSONNEL IN A HOSPI-
21 TAL EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT WHILE SUCH EMPLOYEE IS PERFORMING AN ASSIGNED
22 DUTY IN, OR DIRECTLY RELATED TO SUCH HOSPITAL EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT he or
23 she causes physical injury to such train operator, ticket inspector,
24 conductor, signalperson, bus operator or station agent, city marshal,

36 WHILE SUCH EMPLOYEE IS PERFORMING AN ASSIGNED DUTY IN, OR DIRECTLY
37 RELATED TO SUCH HOSPITAL EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT.

38 S 3. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same
39 manner as chapter 259 of the laws of 2013, takes effect.
