AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to an assault of emergency department personnel while such employee is performing an assigned duty in, or directly related to such hospital emergency department

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 259 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

With intent to prevent a peace officer, a police officer, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal 5 6 procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation 7 enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, a firefighter, including a firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical tech-8 9 nician administering first aid in the course of performance of duty as 10 such firefighter, an emergency medical service paramedic or 11 medical service technician, or medical or related personnel in a hospital emergency department PERFORMING ANY PROFESSIONAL-RELATED DUTIES, a 12 13 city marshal, a traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement agent, from performing a lawful duty, by means including releasing or 14 failing to control an animal under circumstances evincing the actor's 15 intent that the animal obstruct the lawful activity of such peace offi-16 17 police officer, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of 18 section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation 19 worker, firefighter, paramedic, technician, city marshal, 20

- 38 S 3. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 39 manner as chapter 259 of the laws of 2013, takes effect.
