- AN ACT to amend the town law, the village law and the not-for-profit corporation law, in relation to qualifications to serve as a volunteer firefighter

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 16 of section 176-b of the town law, as added 2 by chapter 719 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as follows:

3 16. A person who has been convicted of arson in any degree OR A 4 VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION 5 ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW, shall not be eligible to be elected or appointed as a volunteer member of a fire company. The membership of any volunteer member of a fire company shall 6 7 8 immediately terminate if he is convicted of arson in any degree OR A 9 VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW while a member 10 11 of a fire company.

12 S 2. Subdivision 17 of section 176-b of the town law, as added by 13 chapter 423 of the laws of 1999, is amended to read as follows:

30 S 5. Subparagraph 4 of paragraph (c) of section 1402 of the not-for-31 profit corporation law, as added by chapter 719 of the laws of 1985, is 32 amended to read as follows:

33 A person who has been convicted of arson in any degree OR A (4) VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION 34 ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW, shall not be 35 eligible to be named in the certificate of incorporation of a fire 36 37 corporation, or to be elected or appointed as a volunteer member of a fire corporation. The membership of any volunteer member of a fire 38 39 corporation shall immediately terminate if he OR SHE is convicted of 40 in any degree OR A VIOLATION THAT REOUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE arson SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF 41 THE CORRECTION LAW while a member of a fire corporation. 42

43 S 6. Subparagraph 5 of paragraph (c) of section 1402 of the not-for-44 profit corporation law, as added by chapter 423 of the laws of 1999, is 45 amended to read as follows:

46 (5) Upon application by any person for membership in a fire corpo-47 ration operating pursuant to this section, the fire chief shall cause 48 the applicant's background to be checked pursuant to section eight hundred thirty-seven-o of the executive law 49 for a criminal history 50 involving a conviction for arson AND CAUSE THE APPLICANT'S BACKGROUND TO 51 CHECKED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES OR A LOCAL LAW BEENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR A CRIMINAL HISTORY INVOLVING A CONVICTION 52 THAT 53 REQUIRES REGISTRATION AS A SEX OFFENDER UNDER ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE 54 CORRECTION LAW.

55 S 7. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 56 have become a law.
