AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to unlawful manufacture, production or reproduction of a vehicle identification number with intent to defraud

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 170.65 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
 - (4) HE OR SHE, WITH INTENT TO DEFRAUD, KNOWINGLY MANUFACTURES, PRODUCES OR REPRODUCES A VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER LABEL, STICKER OR PLATE WHICH WAS NOT MANUFACTURED, PRODUCED OR REPRODUCED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE UNITED STATES NATIONAL HIGHWAY SAFETY ADMINISTRATION AND/OR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-10 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
