



1 MAY BE FIXED BY THE OFFICE. THE DIRECTOR MAY APPOINT BUDGET ANALYSTS,  
2 ASSISTANTS AND SUCH OTHER EMPLOYEES AS HE OR SHE MAY DEEM NECESSARY OR  
3 DESIRABLE, PRESCRIBE THEIR DUTIES AND FIX THEIR COMPENSATION WITHIN THE  
4 AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE THEREFOR.

5 4. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL BE CHARGED WITH  
6 THE DUTY OF RENDERING ANTICIPATED REVENUE FORECAST REPORTS TO THE LEGIS-  
7 LATURE AND THE GOVERNOR FOR THE PURPOSES OF FACILITATING PASSAGE OF THE  
8 STATE BUDGET IN A TIMELY MANNER. THE DIRECTOR MAY REQUEST AND SHALL  
9 RECEIVE FROM ALL PUBLIC OFFICERS, DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES AND AUTHORITIES  
10 OF THE STATE AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS, SUCH ASSISTANCE AND DATA AS  
11 SHALL BE NECESSARY TO PROJECT ANTICIPATED STATE REVENUES FOR BUDGETARY  
12 PURPOSES.

13 5. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE ASSISTANCE  
14 IN DETERMINING THE FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION.

15 6. THE NON-PARTISAN LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE  
16 LEGISLATURE WRITTEN ESTIMATES OF ANTICIPATED STATE REVENUES ON JANUARY  
17 FIFTEENTH, APRIL FIFTEENTH, JULY FIFTEENTH AND OCTOBER FIFTEENTH OF EACH  
18 YEAR.

19 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-  
20 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
