AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requirements of proof for certain licenses; and to repeal certain provisions of such law relating thereto

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of section 490 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 487 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:
- (i) The commissioner shall upon submission of an appropriate application, upon payment of the prescribed fee, and upon being satisfied that the person described is the applicant and that such applicant meets the requirements set forth in subdivision two of this section, issue to such applicant a nontransferable identification card. In addition, commissioner also shall require that an applicant for an identification card or renewal thereof provide his or her social security number, PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY 12 NUMBER. SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT 13 THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECU-14
- The commissioner shall provide space so that an applicant 15 RITY NUMBER. may request a notation upon such identification card that he or she is a 16
- 17 veteran of the United States armed forces.

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EXPLANATION -- Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as separately amended by chapters 465 and 487 of the laws of 2012, is REPEALED and a new subdivision 1 is added to read as follows:

APPLICATION FOR LICENSE. APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE SHALL BE MADE TO THE COMMISSIONER. THE FEE PRESCRIBED BY LAW MAY BE SUBMITTED WITH SUCH APPLICATION. THE APPLICANT SHALL FURNISH SUCH PROOF OF IDENTI-TY, AGE, AND FITNESS AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSIONER. THE COMMIS-SIONER MAY ALSO PROVIDE THAT THE APPLICATION PROCEDURE SHALL INCLUDE THE TAKING OF A PHOTO IMAGE OR IMAGES OF THE APPLICANT IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER. IN ADDITION, COMMISSIONER SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE APPLICANT PROVIDE HIS OR HER SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, OR PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ALSO PROVIDE SPACE THE APPLICATION SO THAT THE APPLICANT MAY REGISTER IN THE NEW YORK STATE ORGAN AND TISSUE DONOR REGISTRY UNDER SECTION FORTY-THREE HUNDRED TEN OF PUBLIC HEALTH LAW WITH THE FOLLOWING STATED ON THE APPLICATION IN CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS TYPE:

"YOU MUST FILL OUT THE FOLLOWING SECTION: WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE ADDED TO THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY? CHECK BOX FOR 'YES' OR 'SKIP THIS QUESTION'."

THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL NOT MAINTAIN 24 25 RECORDS OF ANY PERSON WHO CHECKS "SKIP THIS QUESTION". FAILURE TO CHECK A BOX SHALL NOT IMPAIR THE VALIDITY OF AN APPLICATION, AND FAILURE 26 27 "YES" OR CHECKING "SKIP THIS QUESTION" SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO CHECK IMPLY A WISH NOT TO DONATE. IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT UNDER 28 AGE, CHECKING "YES" SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE CONSENT TO MAKE AN 29 ANATOMICAL GIFT OR REGISTRATION IN THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY. WHERE 30 APPLICANT HAS PREVIOUSLY CONSENTED TO MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT OR REGIS-31 32 TERED IN THE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY, CHECKING "SKIP THIS QUESTION" FAILING TO CHECK A BOX SHALL NOT IMPAIR THAT CONSENT OR REGISTRATION. 33 34 THE APPLICATION SHALL ALSO PROVIDE SPACE SO THAT THE APPLICANT REQUEST A NOTATION UPON SUCH LICENSE THAT HE OR SHE IS A VETERAN OF THE 35 UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES. IN ADDITION, AN APPLICANT FOR A COMMERCIAL 36 37 DRIVER'S LICENSE WHO WILL OPERATE A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE IN INTER-STATE COMMERCE SHALL CERTIFY THAT SUCH APPLICANT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS 38 TO OPERATE A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE, AS SET FORTH IN PUBLIC LAW 39 40 99-570, TITLE XII, AND TITLE 49 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS, AND ALL REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF TRANSPOR-41 TATION UNDER THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION ACT. IN ADDITION, AN 42 43 APPLICANT FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT A MEDICAL 44 CERTIFICATE AT SUCH INTERVALS AS REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER 45 SAFETY IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1999 AND PART 383.71(H) OF TITLE 49 FEDERAL REGULATIONS RELATING TO MEDICAL CERTIFICATION AND IN A 47 MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION AND 48 SECTIONS FIVE HUNDRED THREE, FIVE HUNDRED TEN-A, AND FIVE HUNDRED TEN-AA 49 OF THIS TITLE, THE TERMS "MEDICAL CERTIFICATE" AND "MEDICAL CERTIF-50 ICATION" SHALL MEAN A FORM SUBSTANTIALLY IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE FORM SET FORTH IN PART 391.43(H) OF TITLE 49 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS. 51 UPON A DETERMINATION THAT THE HOLDER OF A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE 52 HAS MADE ANY FALSE STATEMENT, WITH RESPECT TO THE APPLICATION FOR SUCH 53 54 LICENSE, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REVOKE SUCH LICENSE.

S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by section two of this act, is amended to read as follows:

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Application for license. Application for a driver's license shall be made to the commissioner. The fee prescribed by law may be submitted with such application. The applicant shall furnish such proof of identity, age, and fitness as may be required by the commissioner. The commissioner may also provide that the application procedure shall include the taking of a photo image or images of the applicant in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner. In addition, commissioner shall require that the applicant provide his or her social security number, or provide proof that he or she is not eligible for a social security number. Such proof may include any documents submitted by an applicant to the United States department of homeland security for the purpose of determining whether such applicant is eligible to receive a social security number. The commissioner shall also provide space on the application so that the applicant may register in the New York state organ and tissue donor registry under section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law [with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type:

"You must fill out the following section: Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'."

The commissioner of the department of health shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under eighteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration]. The application shall also provide space so that the applicant may request a notation upon such license that he or she is a veteran of the United States armed forces. In addition, an applicant for a commercial driver's license who will operate a commercial motor vehicle in interstate commerce shall certify that such applicant meets the requirements operate a commercial motor vehicle, as set forth in public law 99-570, title XII, and title 49 of the code of federal regulations, all regulations promulgated by the United States secretary of transportation under the hazardous materials transportation act. In addition, an applicant for a commercial driver's license shall submit a medical certificate at such intervals as required by the federal motor carrier safety improvement act of 1999 and Part 383.71(h) of title 49 of code of federal regulations relating to medical certification and in a manner prescribed by the commissioner. For purposes of this section and sections five hundred three, five hundred ten-a, and five hundred ten-aa of this title, the terms "medical certificate" and "medical certification" shall mean a form substantially in compliance with the form set forth in Part 391.43(h) of title 49 of the code of federal regulations. Upon a determination that the holder of a commercial driver's license has made any false statement, with respect to the application for such license, the commissioner shall revoke such license.

- S 4. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 6 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by section 3 of part K of chapter 59 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- (a) A license issued pursuant to subdivision five of this section shall be valid until the expiration date contained thereon, unless such

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license is suspended, revoked or cancelled. Such license may be renewed by submission of an application for renewal, the fee prescribed by proofs of prior licensing, fitness and acceptable vision prescribed by the commissioner, AND the applicant's social security number[, and if 5 required by the commissioner] OR PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE 6 ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCU-7 MENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOME-8 LAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. THE COMMISSIONER MAY ALSO 9 10 REQUIRE SUBMISSION OF a photo image of the applicant in such numbers and form as the commissioner shall prescribe. In addition, an applicant for 11 12 renewal of a license containing a hazardous material endorsement shall pass an examination to retain such endorsement. The commissioner shall, 13 14 with respect to the renewal of a hazardous materials endorsement, comply with the requirements imposed upon states by sections 383.141 and 1572.13 of title 49 of the code of federal regulations. A renewal of 15 16 such license shall be issued by the commissioner upon approval of such 17 application, except that no such license shall be issued if its issuance 18 19 would be inconsistent with the provisions of section five hundred sixteen of this title, and except that the commissioner may refuse to 20 renew such license if the applicant is the holder of a currently valid 21 22 or renewable license to drive issued by another state or foreign country 23 unless the applicant surrenders such license. 24

S 5. This act shall take effect immediately; provided however that section three of this act shall take effect October 3, 2016.
