AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the use of coercion to expose immigration status as a misdemeanor offense

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 9 of section 135.60 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 426 of the laws of 2008, is amended and a new subdivision 10 is added to read as follows:
- 9. Perform any other act which would not in itself materially benefit the actor but which is calculated to harm another person materially with respect to his or her health, safety, business, calling, career, financial condition, reputation or personal relationships[.]; OR

- 10. REVEAL OR DISCLOSE SUCH PERSON'S IMMIGRATION STATUS TO A FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR FEDERAL IMMIGRATION AUTHORITY.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next 11 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
