AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of failure to report the death or disappearance of a child

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 260.35 to 2 read as follows:
  - S 260.35 FAILURE TO REPORT THE DEATH OR DISAPPEARANCE OF A CHILD.
- 4 1. A PERSON IS GUILTY OF FAILURE TO REPORT THE DEATH OR DISAPPEARANCE 5 OF A CHILD WHEN:
  - (A) HE OR SHE IS THE PARENT, GUARDIAN OR OTHER PERSON LEGALLY CHARGED WITH THE CARE OR CUSTODY OF A CHILD LESS THAN EIGHTEEN YEARS OLD AND KNOWINGLY OR INTENTIONALLY FAILS TO NOTIFY AND REPORT TO LAW ENFORCEMENT IN A TIMELY MANNER OF TWENTY-FOUR HOURS OR LESS THE DEATH OF SUCH CHILD, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH DEATH WAS ACCIDENTAL OR INTENTIONAL; OR
- 11 (B) HE OR SHE IS THE PARENT, GUARDIAN OR OTHER PERSON LEGALLY CHARGED 12 WITH THE CARE OR CUSTODY OF A CHILD LESS THAN EIGHTEEN YEARS OLD AND 13 KNOWINGLY OR INTENTIONALLY FAILS TO NOTIFY AND REPORT TO LAW ENFORCEMENT 14 IN A TIMELY MANNER OF TWENTY-FOUR HOURS OR LESS OF THE DISAPPEARANCE OF 15 SUCH CHILD.
- 2. A PERSON IS NOT GUILTY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION WHEN HE OR SHE ENGAGES IN THE CONDUCT DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION:
  - (A) WITH THE INTENT THAT THE CHILD BE SAFE FROM PHYSICAL INJURY; OR
- 19 (B) THE CHILD DIES WHILE UNDER MEDICAL CARE FROM A DULY LICENSED 20 PHYSICIAN.
- 21 FAILURE TO REPORT THE DEATH OR DISAPPEARANCE OF A CHILD IS A CLASS D 22 FELONY.
- 23 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
