AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the sale of engine coolant and antifreeze

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 399-j to read as follows:

S 399-J. ENGINE COOLANT AND ANTIFREEZE. 1. ANY ENGINE COOLANT OR ANTI-FREEZE SOLD IN THIS STATE ON OR AFTER JULY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN, THAT IS MANUFACTURED ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THAT CONTAINS MORE THAN TEN PERCENT ETHYLENE GLYCOL, SHALL INCLUDE DENATONIUM BENZOATE AT A MINIMUM OF THIRTY PARTS PER MILLION MAXIMUM OF FIFTY PARTS PER MILLION AS A BITTERING AGENT WITHIN THE PROD-SO AS TO RENDER IT UNPALATABLE. ANOTHER AVERSIVE AGENT MAY BE USED AS A BITTERING AGENT IF IT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE DEGREE OF AVERSION OBTAINED BY UTILIZING THE FORMULATION OF A MINIMUM OF SUBJECTS THIRTY PARTS PER MILLION AND A MAXIMUM OF FIFTY PARTS PER MILLION OF DENATONIUM BENZOATE IN ENGINE COOLANT OR ANTIFREEZE. ANY MANUFACTURER OR PACKAGER OF A PRODUCT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL MAINTAIN A RECORD OF THE TRADE NAME, SCIENTIFIC NAME, AND ACTIVE INGREDIENTS OF ANY BITTERING AGENT USED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTATION MAIN-
