AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to insurance coverage for out-of-network flu shots

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 30 to read as follows:
 - (30) EVERY POLICY THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A FLU SHOT THAT REQUIRES SUCH SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY AN IN-NETWORK PROVIDER SHALL NOT DENY COVERAGE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES THE FLU SHOT FROM AN OUT-OF-NET-WORK PROVIDER.
 - S 2. Subsection (k) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 19 to read as follows:
- (19) EVERY POLICY THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A FLU SHOT THAT REQUIRES SUCH SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY AN IN-NETWORK PROVIDER SHALL NOT DENY COVERAGE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES THE FLU SHOT FROM AN OUT-OF-NET-WORK PROVIDER.
- S 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subsection (jj) to read as follows:
- (JJ) EVERY POLICY THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A FLU SHOT THAT REQUIRES SUCH SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY AN IN-NETWORK PROVIDER SHALL NOT DENY COVERAGE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES THE FLU SHOT FROM AN OUT-OF-NET-WORK PROVIDER.
- 19 S 4. Subsection (b) of section 4322 of the insurance law is amended by 20 adding a new paragraph 28 to read as follows:
 - (28) FLU SHOTS.

22 S 5. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-23 ing the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to 24 insurance policies and contracts issued, renewed, modified or altered on 25 or after such effective date.
