AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the periodic preparation of a state deer management plan by the department of environmental conservation

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 11-0305 of the environmental conservation law is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 19 to read as follows:
- 3 19. TO PREPARE OR CAUSE TO BE PREPARED A STATE DEER MANAGEMENT PLAN 4 FOR THE WHITE-TAILED DEER (ODOCOILEUS VIRGINIANUS) AT LEAST EVERY FIVE 5 YEARS. SAID PLAN SHALL ESTABLISH GOALS FOR DEER MANAGEMENT AND SHALL
 - EVALUATE METHODS FOR POPULATION CONTROL, INCLUDING HUNTING REGULATIONS
- 7 AND FERTILITY CONTROL.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
