AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assault on district attorneys and assistant district attorneys

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 377 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:

With intent to prevent a peace officer, a police officer, DISTRICT ATTORNEY, ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY, ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, a firefighter, including a firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical technician administering first aid in the course of performance of duty as such firefightan emergency medical service paramedic or emergency medical service technician, or medical or related personnel in a hospital emergency department, a city marshal, a traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement agent, from performing a lawful duty, by means releasing or failing to control an animal under circumstances evincing the actor's intent that the animal obstruct the lawful activity of peace officer, police officer, DISTRICT ATTORNEY, ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY, ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation workfirefighter, paramedic, technician, city marshal, traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement agent, he or she causes physical injury to such peace officer, police officer, DISTRICT ATTORNEY, ASSIST-ANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY, ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, firefighter, paramedic, technician or medical or
