AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to the issuance and expiration of food processing establishment licenses

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 251-z-2 of the agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
  - 5. THE TERM "CHAIN STORE" MEANS A FOOD PROCESSING ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS PART OF A NETWORK OF SUBSIDIARIES, AFFILIATES, OR OTHER MEMBER STORES UNDER DIRECT OR INDIRECT CONTROL OF A CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, OR OTHER ORGANIZED ENTITY.
  - S 2. Section 251-z-3 of the agriculture and markets law, as amended by section 1 of part N of chapter 58 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:
  - S 251-z-3. Licenses; fees. No person shall maintain or operate a food processing establishment unless licensed biennially by the commissioner. Application for a license to operate a food processing establishment shall be made, upon a form prescribed by the commissioner. [Renewal applications] A RENEWAL APPLICATION shall be submitted to the commissioner at least thirty days prior to the commencement of the next license period.
- The applicant shall furnish evidence of his or her good character, experience and competency, that the establishment has adequate facilities and equipment for the business to be conducted, that the establishment is such that the cleanliness of the premises can be maintained, that the product produced therein will not become adulterated and, if

the applicant is a retail food store, that the applicant has an individual in a position of management or control who has completed an approved food safety education program pursuant to section two hundred fifty-onez-twelve of this article. The commissioner, if so satisfied, shall issue 5 to the applicant, upon payment of the license fee of four hundred food processing 6 dollars, a license to operate the establishment 7 described in the application. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PRECEDING, AN APPLI-8 CANT THAT IS A CHAIN STORE SHALL PAY A LICENSE FEE OF ONE HUNDRED 9 ITS LICENSE EXPIRES SIX MONTHS OR LESS FROM THE DATE ITS 10 LICENSE PERIOD BEGAN, TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS IF ITS LICENSE EXPIRES BETWEEN SIX MONTHS AND ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE ITS LICENSE 11 PERIOD BEGAN, 12 DOLLARS IF ITS LICENSE EXPIRES BETWEEN ONE YEAR AND EIGHTEEN MONTHS FROM THE DATE ITS LICENSE PERIOD BEGAN, OR FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS 13 14 ITS LICENSE EXPIRES BETWEEN EIGHTEEN MONTHS AND TWO YEARS FROM THE 15 DATE ITS LICENSE PERIOD BEGAN. However, the license fee shall be nine hundred dollars for a food processing establishment determined by the 16 17 commissioner, pursuant to duly promulgated regulations, to require more 18 intensive regulatory oversight due to the volume of the products 19 produced, the potentially hazardous nature of the product produced or 20 the multiple number of processing operations conducted in the establish-21 ment. The license application for retail food stores shall be accompa-22 nied by documentation in a form approved by the commissioner which demonstrates that the food safety education program requirement has been 23 24 met. The license shall take effect on the date of issuance and continue 25 for two years from such date. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PRECEDING, A LICENSE 26 ISSUED TO AN APPLICANT THAT IS A CHAIN STORE SHALL EXPIRE ON THE DATE 27 SET FORTH ON THE APPLICATION FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR 28 SUCH APPLICANT.

29 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
