AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Gold Star Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-b to
2 read as follows:
3 S 344-B. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNED AS THE
4 "GOLD STAR MEMORIAL HIGHWAY". ALL THAT PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
5 SYSTEM CONSTITUTING STATE ROUTE NINETY-SEVEN IN THE TOWN OF HANCOCK,
6 COUNTY OF DELAWARE, BEGINNING AT THE WESTERN BOUNDARY OF THE VILLAGE OF
7 HANCOCK, CONTINUING IN A GENERALLY SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION, AND TERMINATING
8 AT THE DELAWARE AND SULLIVAN COUNTY LINE, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND
9 KNOWN AS THE "GOLD STAR MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".
10 S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation
11 and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system
12 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid
13 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation
14 called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of
15 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be
16 changed as a result of this act.
17 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
