- AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to school zone speed limits and signage and other traffic calming devices

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision a of section 19-177 of the administrative code 2 of the city of New York, as added by local law number 6 of the city of 3 New York for the year 1996, is amended and five new subdivisions d, e, 4 f, g, and h are added to read as follows:

5 a. The official speed limit for a vehicle in the city of New York 6 shall be thirty miles per hour EXCEPT THAT:

1. SCHOOL SPEED LIMITS MAY BE ESTABLISHED AT NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN
8 MILES PER HOUR, FOR A DISTANCE NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED
9 TWENTY FEET ON A HIGHWAY PASSING A SCHOOL BUILDING OR AT AN ENTRANCE OR
10 EXIT OF A SCHOOL ABUTTING A HIGHWAY;

12 2. SENIOR CENTER SPEED LIMITS MAY BE ESTABLISHED AT NOT LESS THAN 12 FIFTEEN MILES PER HOUR FOR A DISTANCE NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND THREE 13 HUNDRED TWENTY FEET ON A HIGHWAY PASSING A SENIOR CENTER BUILDING OR THE 14 ENTRANCE OR EXIT OF A SENIOR CENTER ABUTTING A HIGHWAY. FOR PURPOSES OF 15 THIS SECTION, THE TERM "SENIOR CENTER" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS IN 16 SECTION 21-201 OF THIS CODE;

PARK SPEED LIMITS MAY BE ESTABLISHED AT NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN MILES
 PER HOUR FOR A DISTANCE NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY
 FEET ON A HIGHWAY PASSING A PARK OR AT AN ENTRANCE OR EXIT OF A PARK
 ABUTTING A HIGHWAY. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION THE TERM "PARK"
 SHALL MEAN ANY BUILDING, STRUCTURE, PLAYING FIELD OR LAND CONTAINED

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WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OF LAND OWNED, LEASED OR MAINTAINED BY THE CITY OF 1 2 YORK OR BY ANY NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION OR ELEEMOSYNARY INSTITU-NEW 3 TION, CORPORATION, OR ASSOCIATION WHICH IS USED ON A REGULAR BASIS AS A 4 RECREATION AREA AND IS SO DESIGNATED AND MAY ALSO MEAN ANY OF THE 5 FOLLOWING WHICH HAS THE SAME OWNERSHIP AS THE PARK GROUND: ANY PARKING 6 LOT, PARKING GARAGE, OR OTHER PARKING FACILITY, MARINA, BOAT LAUNCH, OR 7 OTHER SIMILAR FACILITY WHICH IS WITHIN ONE THOUSAND FEET OF AND SERVES 8 SUCH PARK AND WHICH IS SO DESIGNATED BY EASILY VISIBLE SIGNAGE AS SERV-9 ING SUCH PARK;

10 4. PLAYGROUND SPEED LIMITS MAY BE ESTABLISHED AT NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN MILES PER HOUR FOR A DISTANCE NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED 11 TWENTY FEET ON A HIGHWAY PASSING A PLAYGROUND OR AT AN ENTRANCE OR EXIT 12 OF A PLAYGROUND ABUTTING A HIGHWAY. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION THE 13 14 TERM "PLAYGROUND" SHALL MEAN ANY PLAYING FIELD, PLAYGROUND OR LAND 15 CONTAINED WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OF LAND OWNED, LEASED OR MAINTAINED BY THE 16 CITY OF NEW YORK OR BY ANY NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION OR ASSOCIATION 17 WHICH IS USED ON A REGULAR BASIS AS A RECREATION AREA AND IS SO DESIG-18 NATED;

19 5. HOSPITAL SPEED LIMITS MAY BE ESTABLISHED AT NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN
20 MILES PER HOUR FOR A DISTANCE NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED
21 TWENTY FEET ON A HIGHWAY PASSING A HOSPITAL BUILDING OR AT AN ENTRANCE
22 OR EXIT OF A HOSPITAL ABUTTING A HIGHWAY; OR

6. except where an official sign indicates that a different speed limit is in effect.

D. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL POST AT EACH PUBLIC AND NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL, SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT SIGNS. NO PERSON SHALL DRIVE IN EXCESS OF SUCH MAXIMUM SCHOOL SPEED LIMITS DURING:

SCHOOL DAYS AT TIMES INDICATED ON THE SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT SIGN,
 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH TIMES SHALL BE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF SEVEN
 O'CLOCK A.M. AND SIX O'CLOCK P.M. OR ALTERNATIVE TIMES WITHIN SUCH
 HOURS; OR

32 2. A PERIOD WHEN THE BEACONS ATTACHED TO THE SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT 33 SIGN ARE FLASHING AND SUCH SIGN IS EQUIPPED WITH A NOTICE THAT INDICATES 34 THAT THE SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT IS IN EFFECT WHEN SUCH BEACONS ARE 35 FLASHING, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH BEACONS SHALL ONLY FLASH DURING 36 STUDENT ACTIVITIES AT THE SCHOOL AND UP TO THIRTY MINUTES IMMEDIATELY 37 BEFORE AND UP TO THIRTY MINUTES IMMEDIATELY AFTER SUCH STUDENT ACTIV-38 ITIES.

E. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL POST AT EACH SENIOR CENTER SPEED ZONE SPEED
LIMIT SIGNS. NO PERSON SHALL DRIVE IN EXCESS OF SUCH MAXIMUM SPEED
LIMITS DURING THE TIMES INDICATED ON THE SPEED LIMIT SIGN, PROVIDED,
HOWEVER, THAT SUCH TIMES SHALL BE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF SIX O'CLOCK A.M.
AND NINE O'CLOCK P.M. OR ALTERNATIVE TIMES WITHIN SUCH HOURS.

F. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL POST AT EACH PARK ZONE SPEED LIMIT SIGNS. NO
PERSON SHALL DRIVE IN EXCESS OF SUCH MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS DURING THE
TIMES INDICATED ON THE SPEED LIMIT SIGN, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH
TIMES SHALL BE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF SIX O'CLOCK A.M. AND NINE O'CLOCK
P.M., UNLESS OTHER OPEN HOURS ARE POSTED AT ANY PARK.

G. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL POST AT EACH PLAYGROUND ZONE SPEED LIMIT
SIGNS. NO PERSON SHALL DRIVE IN EXCESS OF SUCH MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS
DURING THE TIMES INDICATED ON THE SPEED LIMIT SIGN, PROVIDED, HOWEVER,
THAT SUCH TIMES SHALL BE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF EIGHT O'CLOCK A.M. AND
EIGHT O'CLOCK P.M., UNLESS OTHER OPEN HOURS ARE POSTED AT ANY PLAYGROUND.

55 H. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL POST AT EACH HOSPITAL ZONE SPEED LIMIT 56 SIGNS. NO PERSON SHALL DRIVE IN EXCESS OF SUCH MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS. 27

2. Paragraph 3 of subdivision a and subdivision b of section 19-183 1 S 2 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as added by local 3 law number 64 of the city of New York for the year 2010, are amended and 4 five new subdivisions c, d, e, f and g are added to read as follows: 5 3. "Traffic calming device" shall mean any device, not governed by the 6 manual on uniform traffic control devices, including, but not limited 7 to, speed humps, curb extensions, traffic diverters, FLASHING BEACONS, median barriers and raised walkways, installed on a street and intended 8 to slow, reduce or alter motor vehicle traffic to improve safety for 9 10 pedestrians and bicyclists. The department shall establish guidelines governing the approval 11 b. 12 and placement of traffic calming devices. Such guidelines shall consider whether such traffic calming devices would be installed [adjacent to a 13 14 school or] in a location where a high percentage of seniors use the

15 streets, such as locations adjacent to senior centers and nursing homes, 16 and any other locations as determined by the department. Such guidelines 17 shall list the conditions under which installation of such traffic calm-18 ing device may be appropriate. Such guidelines shall be distributed to 19 any entity upon request and shall be published on the department's 20 website.

C. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INSTALL AND MAINTAIN TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES ADJACENT TO SCHOOLS AND ANY OTHER LOCATIONS AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPART-MENT FOR STUDENT SAFETY AND NO LATER THAN MARCH FIRST OF EACH YEAR, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL A REPORT SETTING FORTH, WITH RESPECT TO THE PRIOR CALENDAR YEAR, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1. THE LOCATION OF EACH SCHOOL SPEED LIMIT ZONE SIGN;

28 2. THE NUMBER OF CITATIONS ISSUED FOR SPEED VIOLATIONS IN EACH SUCH 29 SPEED ZONE;

4. THE EFFECT THAT SUCH SCHOOL SPEED ZONES HAVE ON THE TRAFFIC FLOW AND SPEED VIOLATIONS IN AREAS OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL SPEED LIMIT ZONES.

D. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INSTALL AND MAINTAIN TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES
ADJACENT TO SENIOR CENTERS AS SUCH TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 21-201 OF
THIS CODE, AND NO LATER THAN MARCH FIRST OF EACH YEAR, THE COMMISSIONER
SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL A REPORT SETTING FORTH,
WITH RESPECT TO THE PRIOR CALENDAR YEAR, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

42 1. THE LOCATION OF EACH SENIOR CENTER SPEED LIMIT ZONE SIGN;

43 2. THE NUMBER OF CITATIONS ISSUED FOR SPEED VIOLATIONS IN EACH SUCH 44 SPEED ZONE;

45 THE EFFECT THAT SUCH SENIOR CENTER SPEED LIMIT ZONE SIGNS HAVE ON 3. 46 THE NUMBER OF CITATIONS ISSUED AND NUMBER OF ACCIDENTS OCCURRING WITHIN 47 SUCH PROVIDED THAT SUCH EFFECT SHALL INCLUDE STATISTICS EACH ZONE; 48 REGARDING THE CITATIONS ISSUED AND ACCIDENTS FOR EACH SPEED ZONE DURING 49 THE IMMEDIATELY PRIOR CALENDAR YEAR; AND

50 4. THE EFFECT THAT SUCH SENIOR CENTER SPEED ZONES HAVE ON THE TRAFFIC 51 FLOW AND SPEED VIOLATIONS IN THE AREAS OUTSIDE THE SENIOR CENTER SPEED 52 LIMIT ZONES.

53 E. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INSTALL AND MAINTAIN TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES 54 ADJACENT TO PARKS AS SUCH TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 19-177 OF THIS 55 SUBCHAPTER AND NO LATER THAN MARCH FIRST OF EACH YEAR, THE COMMISSIONER

SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL A REPORT SETTING FORTH, 1 WITH RESPECT TO THE PRIOR CALENDAR YEAR, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION: 2 3 1. THE LOCATION OF EACH PARK SPEED LIMIT ZONE SIGN; 4 2. THE NUMBER OF CITATIONS ISSUED FOR SPEED VIOLATIONS IN EACH SUCH 5 SPEED ZONE; 6 3. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INSTALL AND MAINTAIN TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES 13 F. 14 ADJACENT TO PLAYGROUNDS AS SUCH TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 19-177 OF 15 THIS SUBCHAPTER AND NO LATER THAN MARCH FIRST OF EACH YEAR, THE COMMIS-16 SIONER SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL A REPORT SETTING 17 FORTH, WITH RESPECT TO THE PRIOR CALENDAR YEAR, THE FOLLOWING INFORMA-18 TION: 19 1. THE LOCATION OF EACH PLAYGROUND SPEED LIMIT ZONE SIGN; 20 2. THE NUMBER OF CITATIONS ISSUED FOR SPEED VIOLATIONS IN EACH SUCH 21 SPEED ZONE; 22 3. S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 46 47 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediate-48 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are 49 authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date. 50
