MARTINS, LAVALLE, FUSCHILLO, ZELDIN -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Transportation -- reported favorably from said committee, ordered to first and second report, ordered to a third reading, passed by Senate and delivered to the Assembly, recalled, vote reconsidered, restored to third reading, amended and ordered reprinted, retaining its place in the order of third reading

AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of North Hempstead, county of Nassau, as the "Police Officer Joseph P. Olivieri Jr. Memorial Bridge"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 343-yy  
2     to read as follows:  
3     S 343-YY. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE  
4     "POLICE OFFICER JOSEPH P. OLIVIERI JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE". THE BRIDGE ON  
5     NEW HYDE PARK ROAD WHICH CROSSES INTERSTATE FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE IN  
6     THE TOWN OF NORTH HEMPSTEAD, COUNTY OF NASSAU, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS  
7     THE "POLICE OFFICER JOSEPH P. OLIVIERI JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE".  
8     S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-  
9     lation and maintenance of adequate signage of the state highway system  
10    as designated pursuant to section one of this act; provided that, to  
11    avoid any confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce,  
12    the designations called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be  
13    of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway and bridge  
14    shall not be changed as a result of this act.  
15    S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
