AN ACT making an appropriation to the office for people with developmental disabilities for the purpose of providing additional services and expenses for community programs for people with developmental disabilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The sum of ninety million dollars (\$90,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the office for people with developmental disabilities out of any moneys in the state treasury in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, and made immediately available, for the purposes of this act:

б The amount of such monies necessary shall be determined by the commis-7 sioner of developmental disabilities and director of the budget and shall be based on a recommendation developed by the workgroup appointed 8 pursuant to chapter 53 of the laws of 2013. The workgroup shall develop 9 10 recommendation upon evaluating the extent to which the savings plan its it developed pursuant to budget language included in chapter 53 of the 11 laws of 2013 maintains rates of payment for Medicaid services at levels 12 no less than those in effect on March 31, 2013 and reimbursement levels 13 for any other OPWDD funded programs and services in effect on March 31, 14 15 2013. However to the extent that any additional federal funds or other funds are made available for this purpose those funds may be used to 16 17 offset the requirement to use the full ninety million dollars. To the extent that funding falls short of the amount necessary to fulfill the 18 proposes of this act, no later than December 31, 2013 the director of 19 the budget shall deposit sufficient funds to make up for such shortfall 20 21 to the credit of the general fund. The commissioner of developmental 22 disabilities and director of the budget may also take into account

1 greater efficiencies which do not diminish or impair services or the 2 quality of care as reflected in the recommendations of the workgroup.

3 Ninety million dollars (\$90,000,000) or such amount as determined 4 pursuant to this act shall be made available to the office for people 5 with developmental disabilities immediately for the purpose of providing 6 additional services and expenses for community programs for people with 7 developmental disabilities pursuant to article 41 of the mental hygiene 8 and/or chapter 620 of the laws of 1974, chapter 660 of the laws of law, 1977, chapter 412 of the laws of 1981, chapter 27 of the laws of 1987, 9 10 chapter 729 of the laws of 1989, chapter 329 of the laws of 1993 and any 11 other provisions of the mental hygiene law.

12 Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of law, the appropriation 13 shall be net of refunds, rebates, reimbursements, and credits.

Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of law, the director of the budget is authorized to make sub-allocations from this appropriation up to \$90,000,000 to the department of health medical assistance program for the state share of additional medical assistance services expenses incurred by the department of health for the provision of medical assistance to people with developmental disabilities.

20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, advances and reimbursement 21 made pursuant to subdivision (d) of section 41.15 and section 41.18 of 22 hygiene law shall be allocated pursuant to a plan and in a the mental 23 manner prescribed by the commissioner of developmental disabilities and approved by the director of the budget. No expenditure shall be made 24 25 from this appropriation until a certificate of allocation has been approved by the director of the budget and copies thereof filed with the 26 state comptroller, and the chairs of the senate finance and assembly ways and means committees. The moneys hereby appropriated are available 27 28 29 to reimburse or advance localities and voluntary non-profit agencies for 30 expenditures made during local fiscal periods commencing January 1, 2013, April 1, 2013 or July 1, 2013, and for advances for the 3 month 31 32 period beginning January 1, 2014.

33 Such moneys shall be payable on the audit and warrant of the comp-34 troller on vouchers certified or approved by the commissioner of devel-35 opmental disabilities in the manner prescribed by law.

36 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
