- AN ACT making an appropriation to the office for people with developmental disabilities for the purpose of providing additional services and expenses for community programs for people with developmental disabilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "People 2 with Developmental Disabilities Restoration and Reinvestment Act of 3 2013".

S 2. The sum of ninety million dollars (\$90,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the office for people with developmental disabilities out of any moneys in the state treasury in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, and made immediately available, for the purposes of this act:

9 The amount of such monies necessary shall be determined by the commis-10 sioner of developmental disabilities and director of the budget and shall be based on a recommendation developed by the workgroup appointed 11 12 pursuant to chapter 53 of the laws of 2013. The workgroup shall develop recommendation upon evaluating the extent to which the savings plan 13 its it developed pursuant to budget language included in chapter 53 of the 14 laws of 2013 maintains rates of payment for Medicaid services at levels 15 16 no less than those in effect on March 31, 2013 and reimbursement levels 17 for any other OPWDD funded programs and services in effect on March 31, 18 2013. However to the extent that any additional federal funds or other

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funds are made available for this purpose those funds may be used to 1 2 offset the requirement to use the full ninety million dollars. To the 3 funding falls short of the amount necessary to fulfill the extent that 4 proposes of this act, no later than December 31, 2013 the director of 5 the budget shall deposit sufficient funds to make up for such shortfall 6 the credit of the general fund. The commissioner of developmental to 7 disabilities and director of the budget may also take into account 8 greater efficiencies which do not diminish or impair services or the quality of care as reflected in the recommendations of the workgroup. 9

10 Ninety million dollars (\$90,000,000) or such amount as determined 11 pursuant to this act shall be made available to the office for people with developmental disabilities immediately for the purpose of providing 12 additional services and expenses for community programs for people with 13 14 developmental disabilities pursuant to article 41 of the mental hygiene 15 law, and/or chapter 620 of the laws of 1974, chapter 660 of the laws of 1977, chapter 412 of the laws of 1981, chapter 27 of the laws of 1987, chapter 729 of the laws of 1989, chapter 329 of the laws of 1993 and any 16 17 18 other provisions of the mental hygiene law.

19 Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of law, the appropriation 20 shall be net of refunds, rebates, reimbursements, and credits.

Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of law, the director of the budget is authorized to make sub-allocations from this appropriation up to \$90,000,000 to the department of health medical assistance program for the state share of additional medical assistance services expenses incurred by the department of health for the provision of medical assistance to people with developmental disabilities.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, advances and reimbursement 27 made pursuant to subdivision (d) of section 41.15 and section 41.18 of 28 29 the mental hygiene law shall be allocated pursuant to a plan and in a 30 manner prescribed by the commissioner of developmental disabilities and approved by the director of the budget. No expenditure shall be made 31 32 from this appropriation until a certificate of allocation has been approved by the director of the budget and copies thereof filed with the 33 state comptroller, and the chairs of the senate finance and assembly ways and means committees. The moneys hereby appropriated are available 34 35 ways to reimburse or advance localities and voluntary non-profit agencies for 36 expenditures made during local fiscal periods commencing January 1, 2013, April 1, 2013 or July 1, 2013, and for advances for the 3 month 37 38 period beginning January 1, 2014. 39

Such moneys shall be payable on the audit and warrant of the comptroller on vouchers certified or approved by the commissioner of developmental disabilities in the manner prescribed by law.
