AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to prohibiting mental
health professionals from engaging in sexual orientation change
efforts with a patient under the age of eighteen years

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6509-d
2 to read as follows:
3 S 6509-D. ADDITIONAL DEFINITION OF PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT; MENTAL
4 HEALTH PROFESSIONALS. 1. DEFINITIONS. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:
5 A. "MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL" MEANS A PERSON SUBJECT TO THE
6 PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE OF THIS TITLE IF HE OR SHE
7 SPECIALIZES IN THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHIATRY, OR ARTICLE ONE HUNDRED
8 FIFTY-THREE, ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR OR ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE OF THIS
9 TITLE; OR ANY OTHER PERSON DESIGNATED AS A MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL
10 PURSUANT TO LAW, RULE OR REGULATION.
11 B. "SEXUAL ORIENTATION CHANGE EFFORTS" (I) MEANS ANY PRACTICE BY A
12 MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL THAT SEEKS TO CHANGE AN INDIVIDUAL'S SEXUAL
13 ORIENTATION; AND (II) SHALL NOT INCLUDE PSYCHOTHERAPIES THAT: (A)
14 PROVIDE ACCEPTANCE, SUPPORT AND UNDERSTANDING OF PATIENTS OR THE FACILI-
15 TATION OF PATIENTS' COPING AND SOCIAL SUPPORT, INCLUDING SEXUAL ORIENTA-
16 TION-NEUTRAL INTERVENTIONS TO PREVENT OR ADDRESS UNLAWFUL CONDUCT OR
17 UNSAFE SEXUAL PRACTICES; AND (B) DO NOT SEEK TO CHANGE SEXUAL ORIEN-
18 TATION.
19 2. PROHIBITION. THE LICENSE, REGISTRATION OR CERTIFICATE, ISSUED
20 PURSUANT TO THIS TITLE, OF A MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL SHALL BE
21 REVOKED, SUSPENDED OR ANNULLED, OR SUCH PROFESSIONAL MAY BE SUBJECT TO
22 ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED IN SECTION SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED ELEVEN OF THIS
23 SUBARTICLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS AND PROCEDURES OF THIS

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1 ARTICLE, IF SUCH MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL ENGAGES IN SEXUAL ORIEN-
2 TATION CHANGE EFFORTS UPON ANY PATIENT UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS.
3 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
4 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
