AN ACT in relation to allowing the Franklin Square and Munson Fire District to file an application for exemption from real property taxes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
2     the assessor of the town of Hempstead in the county of Nassau is hereby  
3     authorized to accept from the Franklin Square and Munson Fire District  
4     an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to  
5     section 410 of the real property tax law for the 2012-2013 assessment  
6     roll for the parcel owned by the Franklin Square and Munson Fire  
7     District located in the town of Hempstead, county of Nassau at 833 Hemp-  
8     stead Turnpike, Franklin Square, New York, otherwise known as: district  
9     017, section 36, block 106, lot 0229. If accepted, the application shall  
10    be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable status  
11    date established for such roll.

12    If satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to  
13    such exemption had such organization owned the aforesaid property and  
14    had filed an application for exemption by the appropriate taxable status  
15    date, the assessor of the town of Hempstead, upon approval of the town  
16    board of such town, may grant exemption from taxation, and make appro-  
17    priate corrections to the subject roll. If such exemption is granted and  
18    such organization shall have paid any tax with respect to the subject  
19    roll, the applicable governing body or tax department may, in its  
20    discretion, provide for the refund of taxes paid and cancel taxes,  
21    fines, penalties and interest remaining unpaid.

22    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
