- AN ACT to repeal certain provisions of the general municipal law relating to urban renewal agencies; to repeal certain provisions of the general municipal law relating to industrial development agencies; and to transfer any books, records and remaining rights of any dissolved authority to the municipality for whose purpose the agency was created

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Legislative intent. It is hereby declared to be a substan-1 2 tial interest of this state that residents, governments and businesses 3 have certainty in the corporate status and orderly dissolution of urban renewal agencies and industrial development agencies, and that upon 4 dissolution, their enabling statutes will be repealed and their books, 5 б records and remaining rights, if any, will be transferred to the munici-7 pality for whose purpose the agency was created. The welfare of the state necessitates ensuring that the proliferation of moribund public benefit corporations, such as those included in this act found to be 8 9 10 defunct by the comptroller, the authorities budget office and the New 11 York state commission on public authority reform, does not continue 12 unchecked.
