AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to retaining peace officer status for parole officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 23 of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure 2 law, as amended by section 70 of subpart B of part C of chapter 62 of 3 the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

4 Parole officers or warrant officers in the department of 23. 5 and community supervision AND OFFENDER REHABILITATION COORcorrections 6 DINATORS WHOSE JOB FUNCTIONS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: ASSIGNED TO ONE OR 7 THE STATE'S CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES; PROVIDE GUIDANCE TO AN MORE OF 8 ASSIGNED CASELOAD OF INMATES AND ASSESS NEEDS, PREPARE EVALUATIONS, AND PREPARE ELIGIBLE INMATES FOR RELEASE INTO THE COMMUNITY; MAKE RECOMMEN-9 DATIONS TO THE BOARD OF PAROLE REGARDING INMATE'S READINESS FOR RELEASE; 10 PERFORM BOTH SOCIAL WORK AND LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNCTIONS; TRAINED IN USE 11 OF FIREARMS, HANDLE AND DISCHARGE FIREARMS. 12

13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
