AN ACT to direct the commissioner of education to examine, evaluate and make recommendations on the provision of services by public school guidance counsellors

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The commissioner of education is hereby directed to exam-
2 ine, evaluate and make recommendations on the provision of services to
3 students of the public schools of the state by guidance counsellors.
4 Such commissioner shall study, with particular care:
5 (a) the ratio of guidance counsellors to students, by public school,
6 school district and statewide;
7 (b) the amount of time each guidance counsellor spends with each
8 student during a school year, by public school, school district and
9 statewide;
10 (c) the number of students each guidance counsellor interviews during
11 a school quarter, by public school, school district and statewide;
12 (d) the number of students in each grade that are interviewed by a
13 guidance counsellor during a school quarter, by public school, school
14 district and statewide;
15 (e) the services guidance counsellors provide to students, by public
16 school and school district;
17 (f) the number of hours guidance counsellors are available to students
18 each school day, by public school, school district and statewide;
19 (g) the types and frequency of guidance counsellor services that
20 should be provided to students in public schools.
21 S 2. On or before January 1, 2014, the commissioner of education shall
22 submit a report of its findings, conclusions and recommendations to the
23 governor, the temporary president of the senate, the speaker of the
24 assembly, and the chairs of the senate and assembly committees on educa-
25 tion. Such report shall also include such legislative proposals as the
26 commissioner deems necessary to implement his or her recommendations.
27 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
