AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of Tonawanda, county of Erie, as the "New York State Trooper Kevin Dobson Memorial Bridge"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 343-yy to read as follows:

- S 343-YY. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "NEW YORK STATE TROOPER KEVIN DOBSON MEMORIAL BRIDGE". THE BRIDGE ON INTERSTATE TWO-HUNDRED NINETY WHICH CROSSES NEW YORK ROUTE FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE IN THE TOWN OF TONAWANDA, COUNTY OF ERIE, THE "NEW YORK STATE TROOPER KEVIN DOBSON MEMORIAL BRIDGE".
- S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signage of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act; provided that, to avoid any confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designations called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway and bridge
