AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to unlawful interference with research laboratory operations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 506 to read as follows:
 - S 506. UNLAWFUL INTERFERENCE WITH RESEARCH LABORATORY OPERATIONS. AGENCY AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION EIGHTY-SIX OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS LAW MAY DENY ACCESS TO RECORDS OR PORTIONS CONCERNING BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH OR BIOMEDICAL TEACHING CONDUCTED AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AUTHORIZED STATE BYTHE EDUCATION OR AT AN INSTITUTION WITHIN THE STATE THAT RECEIVES STATE OR FEDERAL FUNDING TO CONDUCT SUCH BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH OR SUCH BIOMEDICAL DISCLOSED, COULD ENDANGER THE LIFE OR SAFETY OF ANY TEACHING THAT, IF
- 10 TEACHING THAT, IF DISCLOSED, COULD ENDANGER THE LIFE OR SAFETY OF ANY 11 PERSON OR WOULD BE REASONABLY LIKELY TO ENDANGER THE SECURITY OF SUCH
