AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to establishing the
Brooklyn health trust

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new article
2 8-A to read as follows:

14 S 810. SHORT TITLE. THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS
15 THE "BROOKLYN HEALTH TRUST ACT".

16 S 811. DEFINITIONS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, THE FOLLOWING TERMS
17 SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING MEANINGS:

18 1. "TRUST" SHALL MEAN THE TRUST CREATED BY SECTION EIGHT HUNDRED
19 TWELVE OF THIS ARTICLE.

20 2. "BOARD" SHALL MEAN THE BOARD OF THE TRUST CREATED BY SECTION EIGHT
21 HUNDRED TWELVE OF THIS ARTICLE.

22 S 812. BROOKLYN HEALTH TRUST. 1. A TRUST TO BE KNOWN AS THE "BROOKLYN
23 HEALTH TRUST" IS HEREBY CREATED UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT
24 AND ITS EXISTENCE SHALL COMMENCE WITH THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MEMBERS OF
25 THE BOARD AS PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE.

EXPLANATION--Matter in *ITALICS* (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
[] is old law to be omitted.

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1 2. THE BOROUGH PRESIDENT OF THE BOROUGH OF BROOKLYN SHALL SERVE EX
2 OFFICIO AND AS CHAIR OF THE BOARD AND SHALL APPOINT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD
3 AS FOLLOWS: THREE MEMBERS WHO ARE RESIDENT MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS FROM
4 THE COUNTY OF KINGS, ONE MEMBER FROM A MEDICAL SCHOOL, TWO MEMBERS FROM
5 RESIDENT BUSINESSES IN THE COUNTY OF KINGS, TWO MEMBERS FROM RESIDENT
6 NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS IN THE COUNTY OF KINGS AND TWO MEMBERS WHO
7 REPRESENT THE COMMUNITY FROM THE COUNTY OF KINGS. MEMBERS OF THE BOARD
8 SHALL BE APPOINTED TO THE BOARD BASED ON THEIR KNOWLEDGE AND BACKGROUND
9 AS RELEVANT TO THE PURPOSES OF THE TRUST, OR THEIR EXPERIENCE AND KNOW-
10 LEDGE IN THE FIELD OF AMBULATORY HEALTH CARE. THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF
11 NEW YORK SHALL APPOINT FIVE MEMBERS FROM AMONG THE GENERAL HOSPITALS IN
12 THE COUNTY OF KINGS BASED ON THEIR KNOWLEDGE AND BACKGROUND AS RELEVANT
13 TO THE PURPOSES OF THE TRUST, OR THEIR EXPERIENCE AND KNOWLEDGE IN THE
14 FIELD OF AMBULATORY HEALTH CARE.

15 3. ONE-THIRD OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE INITIALLY APPOINTED
16 FOR A TERM OF ONE YEAR, ONE-THIRD OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE
17 INITIALLY APPOINTED FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS, AND ONE-THIRD OF THE
18 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE INITIALLY APPOINTED FOR A TERM OF THREE
19 YEARS. MEMBERS MAY BE REAPPOINTED AND MAY SERVE TWO CONSECUTIVE FULL
20 TERMS, IN ADDITION TO THE TERMS OF THEIR ORIGINAL APPOINTMENTS, BUT NOT
21 MORE THAN NINE CONSECUTIVE YEARS. EACH MEMBER SHALL CONTINUE IN OFFICE
22 UNTIL SUCH MEMBER'S SUCCESSOR HAS BEEN APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. SUCH
23 CONTINUATION IN OFFICE SHALL NOT BE COUNTED IN DETERMINING WHETHER A
24 MEMBER HAS SERVED NINE CONSECUTIVE YEARS. IN THE EVENT OF A VACANCY
25 OCCURRING IN THE OFFICE OF ANY MEMBER OF THE BOARD, OTHER THAN BY THE
26 EXPIRATION OF A MEMBER'S TERM, SUCH VACANCY SHALL BE FILLED FOR THE
27 BALANCE OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM, IF APPLICABLE, IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE
28 ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT.

29 4. THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION, BUT
30 SHALL BE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT OF THEIR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY
31 EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES.

32 5. THE POWERS OF THE TRUST SHALL BE VESTED IN AND EXERCISED BY A
33 MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

34 S 813. PURPOSE OF THE TRUST. 1. THE PURPOSE OF THE TRUST SHALL BE TO
35 PROVIDE AMBULATORY HEALTH CARE TO LOW AND MODERATE INCOME RESIDENTS, THE
36 ELDERLY, FRAIL AND DISABLED PERSONS OF THE COUNTY OF KINGS. SUBJECT TO
37 ALL NECESSARY FEDERAL APPROVALS AND THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS, THE TRUST
38 SHALL CONTRACT WITH HOSPITALS IN THE COUNTY OF KINGS, ANY PUBLIC GENERAL
39 HOSPITAL, AND/OR WITH ANY SPONSORING LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF SUCH PUBLIC
40 GENERAL HOSPITAL, IN ORDER TO FUND THE NON-FEDERAL SHARE OF MEDICAID
41 FUNDS. THE TRUST SHALL BE ABLE TO ACCEPT PAYMENT FROM INSURANCE CARRI-
42 ERS, MEDICAID, AND MEDICARE.

43 2. THE TRUST SHALL BE FUNDED FROM ALL MONIES DERIVED FROM THE SALE OR
44 CONVEYANCE OF LONG ISLAND COLLEGE HOSPITAL AS DESCRIBED IN THIS ARTICLE.

45 3. NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS SECTION SHALL PREVENT THE TRUST FROM
46 RECEIVING GRANTS, GIFTS OR BEQUESTS AND DEPOSITING THEM INTO THE TRUST
47 ACCORDING TO LAW.

48 4. THE TRUST SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO ADOPT AND FROM TIME TO TIME TO
49 AMEND SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AND TO PRESCRIBE SUCH CONDITIONS, NOT
50 INCONSISTENT WITH LAW, AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE
51 PEOPLE OF THE STATE THE RELIEF AND ASSISTANCE AFFORDED BY ANY ACT OF
52 CONGRESS FOR PUBLIC HEALTH WORK IN THE STATE.

53 5. MONIES IN THIS TRUST SHALL ONLY BE USED FOR PURPOSES ESTABLISHED
54 UNDER SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION.

55 S 814. FUNDING. THE TRUST SHALL INITIALLY BE FUNDED IN AN AMOUNT
56 EQUAL TO THE PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM THE SALE OF ASSETS OF LONG ISLAND

18 S 815. REPORTS. NOT LATER THAN NINETY DAYS FOLLOWING THE END OF THE
19 STATE FISCAL YEAR THE TRUST SHALL ANNUALLY SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR, THE
20 TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY A
21 REPORT ON THE PRIORITIES AND FINANCES OF THE TRUST.

22 S 816. ASSISTANCE OF OTHER AGENCIES. THE TRUST BOARD MAY REQUEST FROM
23 ANY STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE AND THE SAME ARE
24 AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE SUCH ASSISTANCE AND INFORMATION AS WILL ENABLE IT
25 TO CARRY OUT ITS PURPOSE AND POWERS PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE.

26 S 817. MEMBERS NOT TO PROFIT. NO MEMBER OF THE TRUST SHALL RECEIVE OR
27 MAY BE LAWFULLY ENTITLED TO RECEIVE ANY PECUNIARY PROFIT FROM THE OPERA-
28 TION OF THE TRUST.

29 S 818. BROOKLYN HEALTH COMMISSION. WITHIN NINETY DAYS AFTER THE ESTAB-
30 LISHMENT OF THE TRUST, THE TRUST SHALL ESTABLISH AND FUND THE BROOKLYN
31 HEALTH COMMISSION. FUNDING FOR THE COMMISSION SHALL BE MADE BY THE TRUST
32 IN AN AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION DOLLARS. THE COMMISSION SHALL EXPEND THE
33 FUNDS FOR A STUDY OF THE HEALTH NEEDS OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY OF
34 KINGS AND PREPARE A PLAN TO ADDRESS SUCH NEEDS, IN PART, BY THE TRUST.

35 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
