AN ACT to amend the public officers law and the legislative law, in relation to the prohibition of naming buildings after public officials

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The public officers law is amended by adding a new section 2 79-a to read as follows:
 - S 79-A. PROHIBITION ON THE NAMING OF BUILDINGS. NO PERSON WHO IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL HAVE A BUILDING NAMED OR CAUSE A BUILDING TO BE NAMED AFTER HIMSELF OR HERSELF WHILE HE OR SHE HOLDS PUBLIC OFFICE BASED ON THE FACT THAT SUCH PERSON WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR SECURING PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE PERSON OR ENTITY INVOLVED IN NAMING THE BUILDING OR FOR SECURING PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE PERSON'S OR ENTITY'S CAUSE OR AGENDA.
- 10 S 2. The legislative law is amended by adding a new section 7-h to 11 read as follows:
- 7-H. PROHIBITION ON NAMING OF BUILDINGS. NO PERSON WHO IS 12 THESUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL HAVE A BUILDING NAMED OR 13 14 CAUSE A BUILDING TO BE NAMED AFTER HIMSELF OR HERSELF WHILE HE OR SHE PUBLIC OFFICE BASED ON THE FACT THAT SUCH PERSON WAS RESPONSIBLE 15 FOR SECURING PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE PERSON OR ENTITY INVOLVED 16 17 BUILDING OR FOR SECURING PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE PERSON'S OR ENTITY'S CAUSE OR AGENDA. 18
- 19 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
