AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to performance of illegal maneuvers while operating a motorcycle

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1254 to read as follows:

- S 1254. PERFORMANCE OF AN ILLEGAL MANEUVER WHILE OPERATING A MOTORCY-"ILLEGAL MANEUVER" SHALL MEAN ANY MANEUVER PERFORMED BY THE OPERATOR OF A MOTORCYCLE WHICH REQUIRES THE FRONT OR REAR WHEEL OF MOTORCYCLE TO LEAVE CONTACT WITH THE ROAD, OR ANY MANEUVER DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISIONS (B) AND (C) OF SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO OF THIS ILLEGAL MANEUVER SHALL A MANEUVER PERFORMED BY A NOTMEAN MOTORCYCLE WITH A SIDE PASSENGER TRUCK ATTACHMENT, IN WHICH TRUCK LEAVES THE ROAD IN THE COURSE OF TAKING A TURN.
- (B) AN OPERATOR OF A MOTORCYCLE THAT PERFORMS AN ILLEGAL MANEUVER THAT RESULTS IN PROPERTY DAMAGE OR BODILY HARM OF ANOTHER SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND THE AUTOMATIC REVOCATION OF THE OPERATOR'S LICENSE AND REGISTRATION FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR.
- (C) AN OPERATOR OF A MOTORCYCLE THAT PERFORMS AN ILLEGAL MANEUVER THAT 16 17 IN PROPERTY DAMAGE OR BODILY HARM OF ANOTHER WITHIN EIGHTEEN MONTHS OF A PRIOR CONVICTION WHERE THE VIOLATOR PERFORMED AN 18 ILLEGAL 19 MANEUVER THAT RESULTED INPROPERTY DAMAGE OR BODILY HARM OF ANOTHER, 20 SHALL BE PUBLISHABLE BY THE FORFEITURE OF THE OPERATOR'S MOTORCYCLE AUTOMATIC REVOCATION OF THE OPERATOR'S LICENSE AND REGISTRATION FOR 21 22 A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS.
- S 2. Subparagraphs (x) and (xi) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 510 of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 571 of the laws of 2006, are amended and two new subparagraphs (xii) and (xiii) are added to read as follows:

- 14 (XII) OF A VIOLATION OF SUBDIVISION (B) OF SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED 15 FIFTY-FOUR OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL RESULT IN A LICENSE AND REGISTRATION 16 REVOCATION OF ONE YEAR; OR
 - (XIII) OF A SECOND VIOLATION OF SUBDIVISION (B) OF SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL RESULT IN A LICENSE AND REGISTRATION REVOCATION OF TWO YEARS.
- 20 S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred sixtieth day after 21 it shall have become a law.
