AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to muzzle-loading deer hunting seasons in the southern zone

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph b of subdivision 8 of section 11-0907 of the 2 environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 241 of the laws of 3 1997, is amended to read as follows:

b. Such special open season for the Southern Zone shall be for the [seven] FOURTEEN day period immediately preceding the regular open season for deer stated in column two of the table set forth in subdivision [2] TWO OF THIS SECTION, except that the department may, by regulation, fix such open season in the Southern Zone or any portion thereof to be either the [seven] FOURTEEN days immediately preceding or immediately following the regular open season for deer.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
