AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to trustees of the state university and city university

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 353 of the education law, as
2 amended by chapter 268 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 1. The state university shall be governed, and all of its corporate
5 powers exercised, by a board of trustees. Such board shall consist of
6 eighteen members, fifteen of whom shall be appointed by the governor
7 with the advice and consent of the senate, one of whom shall be the
8 president of the student assembly of the state university, ex-officio
9 and voting, one of whom shall be the president of the university faculty
10 senate, ex-officio and non-voting; PROVIDED THAT NO SUCH MEMBER, EXCEPT
11 THE PRESIDENT OF THE STUDENT ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY OR ANY
12 CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEE, SHALL BE THE EMPLOYEE OF, OR UNDER
13 THE SUPERVISION OF, THE GOVERNOR, and one of whom shall be the president
14 of the faculty council of community colleges, ex-officio and non-voting.
15 Such ex-officio members shall be subject to every provision of any
16 general, special, or local law, ordinance, charter, code, rule, or regu-
17 lation applying to the voting members of such board with respect to the
18 discharge of their duties, including, but not limited to, those
19 provisions setting forth codes of ethics, disclosure requirements, and
20 prohibiting business and professional activities. One member of the
21 board shall be designated by the governor as chairperson and one as
22 vice-chairperson. Of the members first appointed, two shall be appointed
23 for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred
24 fifty-two; one for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen

1 hundred fifty-three; two for a term which shall expire on June thirti-
2 eth, nineteen hundred fifty-four; one for a term which shall expire on
3 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred fifty-five; two for a term which shall
4 expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred fifty-six; one for a term
5 which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred fifty-seven; two
6 for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred
7 fifty-eight; one for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nine-
8 teen hundred fifty-nine; two for a term which shall expire on June thir-
9 tieth, nineteen hundred sixty; and one for a term which shall expire on
10 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred sixty-one. Vacancies shall be filled
11 for the unexpired term in the same manner as original appointments. The
12 term of office of each trustee appointed on or after April first, nine-
13 teen hundred eighty-six shall be seven years, except those of the
14 student member and the faculty members. Trustees shall receive no
15 compensation for their services but shall be reimbursed for their
16 expenses actually and necessarily incurred by them in the performance of
17 their duties under this article.

18 S 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 6204 of the education
19 law, as added by chapter 305 of the laws of 1979, is amended to read as
20 follows:

21 (a) The board of trustees shall consist of seventeen trustees. Ten of
22 the trustees shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and
23 consent of the senate; PROVIDED THAT NO SUCH TRUSTEE, EXCEPT ANY CLASSI-
24 FIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEE, SHALL BE AN EMPLOYEE OF, OR UNDER THE
25 SUPERVISION OF, THE GOVERNOR. Five of the trustees shall be appointed
26 by the mayor of the city of New York with the advice and consent of the
27 senate; PROVIDED THAT NO SUCH TRUSTEE, EXCEPT ANY CLASSIFIED CIVIL
28 SERVICE EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, SHALL BE AN EMPLOYEE OF, OR
29 UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF, THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK. One ex-of-
30 ficio trustee shall be the chairperson of the university student senate.
31 One ex-officio non-voting trustee shall be the chairperson of the
32 university faculty senate.

33 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to board
34 members of the state university of New York and trustees of the city
35 university of New York appointed on or after such effective date.
