AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to actions by health care providers against patients

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 3224-d 2 to read as follows:
 - 3224-D. ACTIONS BY HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS RELATED TO INSURANCE CLAIMS. IN ANY ACTION BROUGHT BY Α HEALTH CARE PROVIDER AGAINST A TO RECOVER PAYMENT FOR AN OUTSTANDING BILL, PATIENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY SUCH HEALTH PROVIDER, CARE ΙT SHALL $_{
 m BE}$ AN AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE TO SUCH ACTION THAT THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER FAILED TO SUBMIT THE INSURANCE CLAIM TO THE PATIENT'S INSURER IN A TIMELY MANNER.
