AN ACT to authorize a certain individual to take the competitive civil service examination and be placed on the eligible list for appointment as a full-time police officer for the village of Southampton, county of Suffolk

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding section 58 of the civil service law or any other law to the contrary, Gregg Keghlian, who has been continuously employed by the village of Southampton, in the county of Suffolk, as a full-time court officer and part-time police officer with the police department of the village of Southampton, shall be eligible to take the competitive civil service examination for the position of police officer and shall, contingent upon his score on such examination, be eligible to be placed on the eligible list for appointment as a full-time police officer with the police department of such village.

10 S 2. Gregg Keghlian shall be otherwise subject to the merit and 11 fitness provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time 12 police officers.

13 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
