AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the definition of "electronic cigarette" or "e-cigarette"; and to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting the provision of any quantity of an electronic liquid

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 13 of section 1399-aa of the public health law, as added by chapter 448 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:

- 13. "Electronic cigarette" or "e-cigarette" means a battery-operated device that contains cartridges OR LIQUIDS filled with a combination of nicotine[, flavor] and chemicals that are turned into vapor which is inhaled by the user.
- S 2. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 391-t to read as follows:
- S 391-T. ELECTRONIC LIQUIDS OR E-LIQUIDS; PROHIBITION. 1. NO PERSON, 11 FIRM, CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY 12 OR OTHER ENTITY SHALL SELL, OFFER TO SELL OR GIVE AWAY, FOR EITHER 13 RETAIL, WHOLESALE OR PROMOTIONAL PURPOSES, AN ELECTRONIC LIQUID OR E-LI-14 QUID.
- 2. ANY PERSON, FIRM, CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, LIMITED 15 LIABILITY COMPANY OR OTHER ENTITY THAT VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDI-16 17 VISION ONE OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR EACH SEPARATE 18 VIOLATION OF SUCH 19 SUBDIVISION, TO BE RECOVERED BY ANY ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY DESIGNATED BY 20 MUNICIPALITY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN WHICH SUCH 21 OCCURRED.
- 3. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "ELECTRONIC LIQUID" OR "E-LIQUID" 22 23 MEANS A LIQUID COMPOSED OF NICOTINE AND OTHER CHEMICALS, AND WHICH IS 24 SOLD AS A PRODUCT THAT MAY BE USED IN AN ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE, 25 SUBDIVISION SECTION THIRTEEN HUNDRED DEFINED BYTHIRTEEN OF NINETY-NINE-AA OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW. 26
- 27 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 28 have become a law.
