AN ACT in relation to extending the deadline by which an eligible municipality may exercise the provisions of the Superstorm Sandy assessment relief act

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of chapter 424 of the laws of 2013 to the contrary, any school district within the town of Smithtown may exercise the provision of the Superstorm Sandy assessment relief act, within one year of this act being adopted into law, upon the passage of a resolution adopting the provisions thereof. Any school district within the town of Smithtown may provide assessment relief for real property impacted by Superstorm Sandy located within the district in accordance with paragraphs (i), (ii), (iii) and/or (iv) of subdivision (a) of section four of the Superstorm Sandy assessment relief act only after passage of a resolution electing to do so.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
