- AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to a public awareness educational program on heroin; and making an appropriation therefor

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 19.09 of the mental hygiene law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision (i) to read as follows:

3 (I) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL CREATE A MULTI-FACETED PUBLIC OUTREACH 4 PROGRAM TO RAISE AWARENESS OF THE INHERENT DANGERS AND COSTS OF HEROIN 5 USE. THE PROGRAM SHALL CONSIST OF SUCH PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS AND 6 INTERACTIVE MEDIA SPOTS DESIGNED TO REACH THE BROADEST POSSIBLE GENERAL AUDIENCE, AS WELL AS THOSE DESIGNED TO SPECIFICALLY TARGET THOSE 7 SOCIAL 8 THAT ARE MOST AT RISK FOR EXPERIMENTING WITH HEROIN, AND AGE GROUPS 9 THOSE WHO ARE CURRENTLY USING HEROIN, AND THOSE WHO ARE SEEKING OR UNDERGOING TREATMENT FOR HEROIN ADDICTION. THE CONTENT OF SUCH OUTREACH 10 EFFORTS SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, SUCH TOPICS AS: THE 11 12 DANGERS OF ADDICTION AFTER ONLY ONE USE; SECTION 220.78 OF THEPENAL 13 LAW, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS NEW YORK STATE'S GOOD SAMARITAN LAW; THE CURRENT DEMOGRAPHICS OF HEROIN ADDICTION; THE RECOGNIZABLE PHYSIOLOGICAL SYMP-14 TOMS OF ADDICTION; THE AVAILABILITY AND THE 15 CRITICAL EFFECTIVENESS OF ADMINISTERING AN OPIOID ANTAGONIST IN CASES OF SUSPECTED OVERDOSE; AND 16 17 THE AVAILABILITY OF THE OFFICE'S HOPELINE. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL POST ANNOUNCEMENTS, EXAMINE ALL POSSIBLE METHODOLOGIES, AND TAKE ALL 18 THE 19 OTHER EFFORTS, INCLUDING THE USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA SITES, TO ENSURE THAT 20 ANNOUNCEMENTS ARE VIEWED BY THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PEOPLE. THE THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ALSO PROVIDE COPIES OF 21 THE ANNOUNCEMENTS ON ITS IN A HIGHLY VISIBLE LOCATION THAT ARE AVAILABLE TO BE FREELY 22 WEBSITE 23 DOWNLOADED BY ANY MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC.

S 2. The sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the department of mental hygiene out of any moneys in the state treasury in the general

1 fund to the credit of the office of alcoholism and substance abuse 2 services, not otherwise appropriated, and made immediately available, 3 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act. Such moneys 4 shall be payable on the audit and warrant of the comptroller on vouchers 5 certified or approved by the commissioner of the office of alcoholism 6 and substance abuse services in the manner prescribed by law. 7 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
