- AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to prohibiting the sale of concentrated alcoholic beverages

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 7-e to read as follows:

3 7-E. "CONCENTRATED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE" MEANS ANY POWDERS, CRYSTALS, 4 LIQUID OR OTHER SUBSTANCE WHICH, AFTER BEING MIXED WITH SUGAR, WATER OR 5 ANY OTHER NONALCOHOLIC MATERIALS, FERMENTS OR OTHERWISE BECOMES AN ALCO-6 HOLIC BEVERAGE.

7 S 2. Section 100 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by 8 adding a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:

9 1-A. NO PERSON SHALL SELL, OR OFFER FOR SALE ANY CONCENTRATED ALCOHOL-10 IC BEVERAGE.

11 S 3. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
