AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to motor vehicle law enforcement fees

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 9110 of the insurance law, as
2 amended by section 1 of part T of chapter 56 of the laws of 2009, is
3 amended to read as follows:
4 (b) The annual fee is hereby imposed at the rate of [ten] FIVE dollars
5 per insured motor vehicle registered pursuant to the provisions of para-
6 graph b of subdivision one of section four hundred one of the vehicle
7 and traffic law. Provided, however, that such fee shall be reduced by
8 fifty percent per insured motor vehicle registered pursuant to the
9 provisions of paragraph b of subdivision one of section four hundred one
10 of the vehicle and traffic law where a policy issued in the state or for
11 delivery in the state for motor vehicle liability insurance coverage is
12 for a term of six months or less. Such fee will be paid monthly by
13 insurance companies to the superintendent on or before the fifteenth of
14 the month next succeeding the month in which such collections are
15 received.
16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
17 have become a law.
