AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to void and voidable claims

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law is  
2     amended by adding a new section 104-a to read as follows:  
3     S 104-A. VOID CLAIMS. A CLAIM FOR A HORSE IN A THOROUGHBRED CLAIMING  
4     RACE SHALL BE VOID FOR ANY HORSE THAT DIES DURING A RACE OR IS EUTHAN-  
5     IZED ON THE TRACK FOLLOWING A RACE.  
6     S 2. The racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law is amended by  
7     adding a new section 104-b to read as follows:  
8     S 104-B. VOIDABLE CLAIM. A CLAIM FOR A HORSE IN A THOROUGHBRED CLAIM-  
9     ING RACE IS VOIDABLE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE NEW OWNER, FOR A PERIOD OF  
10    ONE HOUR AFTER THE RACE IS MADE OFFICIAL, FOR ANY HORSE THAT IS VANNED  
11    OFF THE TRACK AFTER THE RACE.  
12    S 3. The commission shall prescribe such regulations as are necessary  
13    to carry out the provisions of this act.  
14    S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
