AN ACT to authorize approval of certain transportation contracts of the Massapequa union free school district

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. All the acts done and proceedings heretofore had and taken
2 or caused to be had and taken by the Massapequa union free school
3 district and by all officers, employees or agents of such school
4 district relating to or in connection with transportation contracts
5 E252772, C257560, C257561, E257537, E257538, E257539, E257540, E257541,
6 E257542, E257543, E257547, E257533, E257535, E257536, E259186, E259185,
7 E259184, E257527, E257571, E257572, E257573, E254910, E610509, E009273,
8 E600691B, E252770, E253710, E961006, E253715, E61133C, and E253714 of
9 the 2008-2009 through 2011-2012 school years, and all acts incidental
10 thereto are hereby legalized, validated, ratified and confirmed,
11 notwithstanding any failure to comply with the contract award, approval,
12 and filing provisions of the education law, the general municipal law or
13 any other law or any other statutory authority, rule or regulations,
14 other than those filing provisions defined in paragraph a of subdivision
15 5 of section 3604 of the education law, in relation to any omission,
16 error, defect, irregularity or illegality in such proceeding had and
17 taken.

18 S 2. The education department is hereby directed to consider the
19 aforementioned contracts for transportation aid as valid and proper
20 obligations of the Massapequa union free school district.

21 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
