AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating certain persons appointed by a county sheriff's office as peace officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 84 to read as follows:

- 7 FORENSIC, SCIENTIFIC, OR AVIATION. SUCH PERSONS MUST HAVE SUCCESSFULLY
- 8 COMPLETED PEACE OFFICER TRAINING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2.30 OF THIS ARTI-
- 9 CLE. NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED TO AUTHORIZE SUCH OFFI-
- 10 CER OR AGENT TO CARRY, POSSESS, REPAIR, OR DISPOSE OF A FIREARM UNLESS 11 THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE THEREFOR HAS BEEN ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION
- 12 400.00 OF THE PENAL LAW.
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
