AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to state appropriations to the state university of New York and the city university of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Clause (iv) of subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law, as amended by section 1 of part D of chapter 54 of the laws of 2016, is renumbered clause (v) and a new clause (iv) is added to read as follows:

5 (IV) THE STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL 6 FUND OPERATING SUPPORT INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE STATE UNIVER-7 SITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE 8 THE STATE UNIVERSITY INSTATE FISCAL YEAR OWT THOUSAND ABLE TO 9 ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE. BEGINNING IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND 10 SEVENTEEN--TWO THOUSAND EIGHTEEN AND THEREAFTER, THE STATE SHALL AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUPPORT FOR THE STATE 11 UNIVERSITY AND THE STATE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTERS IN AN 12 13 LESS THAN THE AMOUNTS SEPARATELY APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE IN THE PRIOR STATE FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDED, FURTHER, THE STATE 14 15 PRIATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUPPORT TO COVER ALL MANDATORY COSTS OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE STATE UNIVERSITY 16 SCIENCE CENTERS, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, COLLECTIVE 17 18 BARGAINING COSTS INCLUDING SALARY INCREMENTS, FRINGE BENEFITS, AND OTHER 19 NON-PERSONAL SERVICE COSTS SUCH AS UTILITY COSTS, BUILDING RENTALS 20 OTHER INFLATIONARY EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE 21 STATE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTERS. ΙF THEGOVERNOR, HOWEVER, 22 DECLARES A FISCAL EMERGENCY, AND COMMUNICATES SUCH EMERGENCY TO THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND SPEAKER OF 23 ASSEMBLY, THESTATE FOR OPERATING EXPENSES AT THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND CITY UNIVER-24 SUPPORT

S 2. The opening paragraph of subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law, as amended by chapter 437 of the laws of 2015, is designated clause (i) and a new clause (ii) is added to read as follows:

5 STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL 6 FUND OPERATING SUPPORT INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE STATE UNIVER-7 IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAIL-STATE UNIVERSITY IN 8 STATE FISCAL YEAR ABLE THE TWO THOUSAND 9 ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE. BEGINNING IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND 10 SEVENTEEN--TWO THOUSAND EIGHTEEN AND THEREAFTER, THE STATE SHALL APPRO-11 PRIATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUPPORT FOR THE AND THE STATE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTERS IN AN AMOUNT 12 UNIVERSITY NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNTS SEPARATELY APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE 13 14 PRIOR STATE FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDED, FURTHER, THE STATE SHALL APPRO-15 PRIATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUPPORT TO COVER ALL 16 MANDATORY COSTS OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE STATE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTERS, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, COLLECTIVE 17 BARGAINING COSTS INCLUDING SALARY INCREMENTS, FRINGE BENEFITS, AND OTHER 18 19 NON-PERSONAL SERVICE COSTS SUCH AS UTILITY COSTS, BUILDING RENTALS AND 20 OTHER INFLATIONARY EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND 21 UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTERS. IF THE GOVERNOR, HOWEVER, 22 DECLARES A FISCAL EMERGENCY, AND COMMUNICATES SUCH EMERGENCY TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE STATE 23 24 SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES AT THE STATE UNIVERSITY AND CITY UNIVER-25 SITY MAY BE REDUCED IN A MANNER PROPORTIONATE TO ONE ANOTHER, 26 AFOREMENTIONED PROVISIONS SHALL NOT APPLY.

- S 3. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 of the education law, as amended by section 2 of part D of chapter 54 of the laws of 2016, is amended by adding a new subparagraph (iv) to read as follows:
- STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE STATE (IV) THE SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES, INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE CITY UNIVERSITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAT THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE TO THE CITY UNIVERSITY IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE. BEGINNING IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN--TWO THOUSAND EIGHTEEN AND THEREAFTER, THE STATE SHALL APPRO-PRIATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE STATE SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSE FOR CITY UNIVERSITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNTS SEPARATELY APPRO-PRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE IN THE PRIOR STATE FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDED, FURTHER, THE STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE GENERAL OPERATING SUPPORT TO COVER ALL MANDATORY COSTS OF THE CITY UNIVERSITY, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COSTS, INCLUDING SALARY INCREMENTS, FRINGE BENEFITS, AND OTHER NON-PERSONAL SERVICE COSTS SUCH AS UTILITY COSTS, BUILDING RENTALS AND OTHER INFLA-TIONARY EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE CITY UNIVERSITY. IF THEHOWEVER, DECLARES A FISCAL EMERGENCY, AND COMMUNICATES SUCH EMERGENCY TO TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, STATE SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY UNIVERSITY MAY BE REDUCED IN A MANNER PROPORTIONATE TO ONE ANOTHER, AND THE AFOREMENTIONED PROVISIONS SHALL NOT APPLY.
- S 4. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 of the education law, as amended by chapter 327 of the laws of 2002, is amended by adding a new subparagraph (iv) to read as follows:
- (IV) THE STATE SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY AND MAKE AVAILABLE STATE SUPPORT FOR OPERATING EXPENSES, INCLUDING FRINGE BENEFITS, FOR THE CITY UNIVERSITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE TO THE CITY UNIVERSITY IN STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND

- S 5. This act shall take effect immediately provided that:
- (a) the amendments to subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such subparagraph pursuant to chapter 260 of the laws of 2011, as amended, when upon such date section two of this act shall take effect; and
- 23 (b) the amendments to paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 24 of the education law made by section three of this act shall be subject 25 to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to chapter 26 260 of the laws of 2011, as amended when upon such date section four of 27 this act shall take effect.
